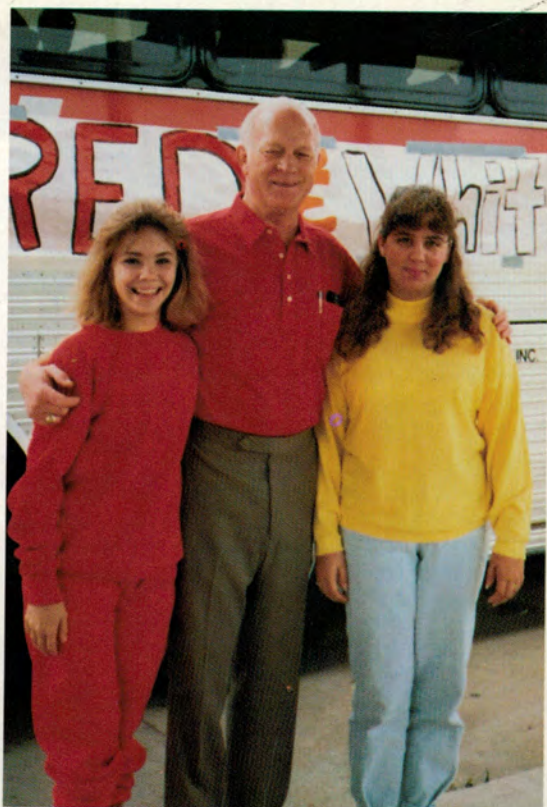

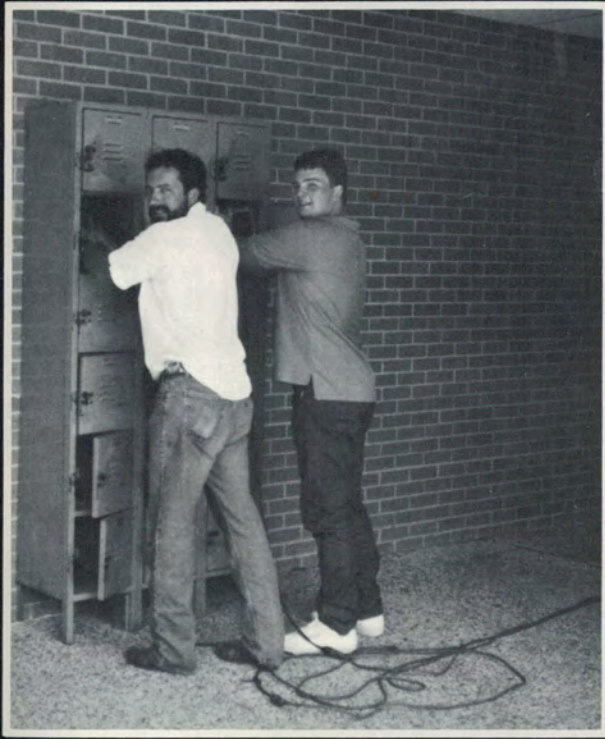

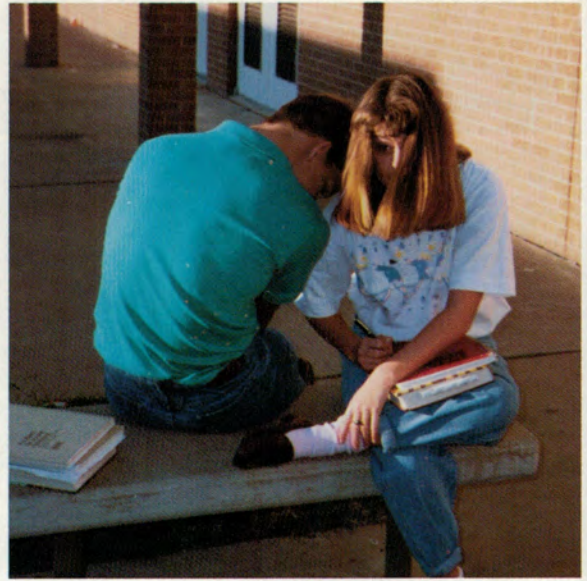
During those first days and weeks of school, many situations were encountered — students changed their schedules, searched for lost classrooms, fought their way into the crowded cafeteria, and made new friends.

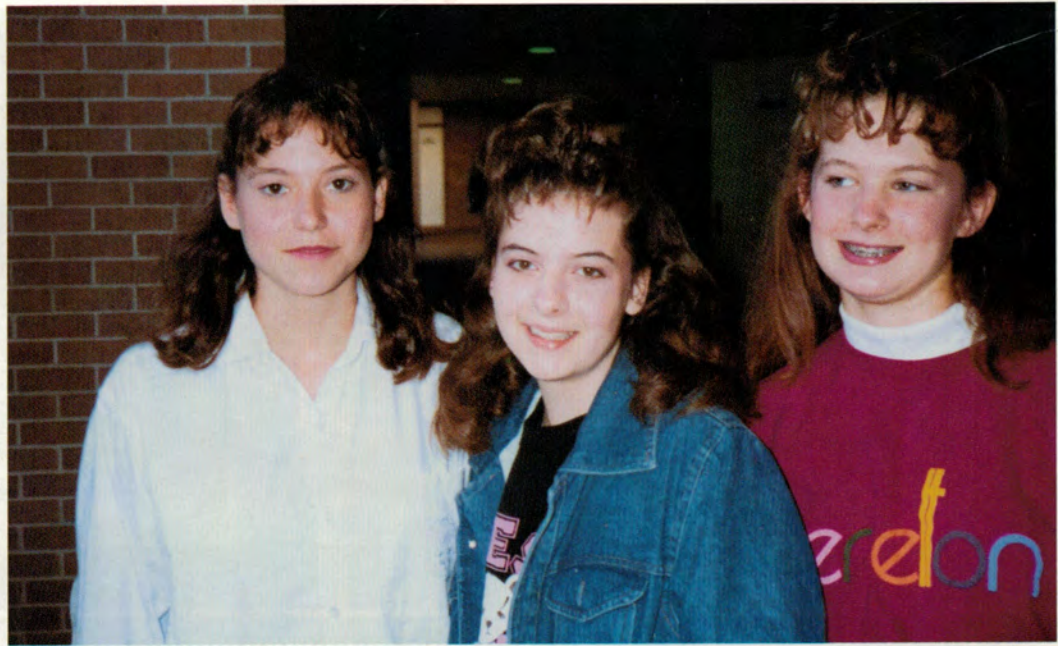

By the end of the school year, administrators, teachers, and students came to one unified conclusion — TOGETHER WE ARE BETTER!











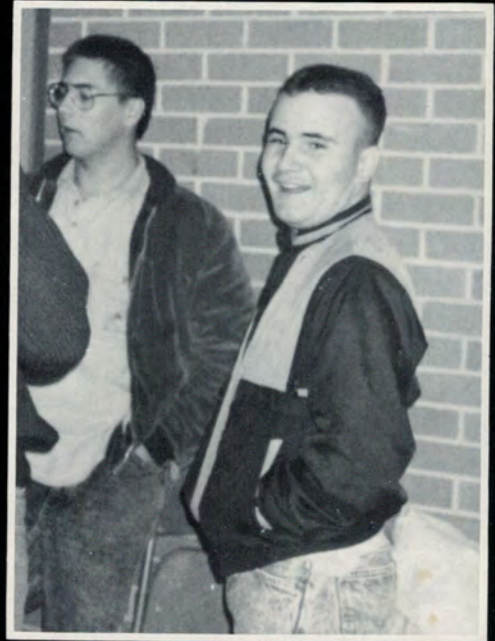


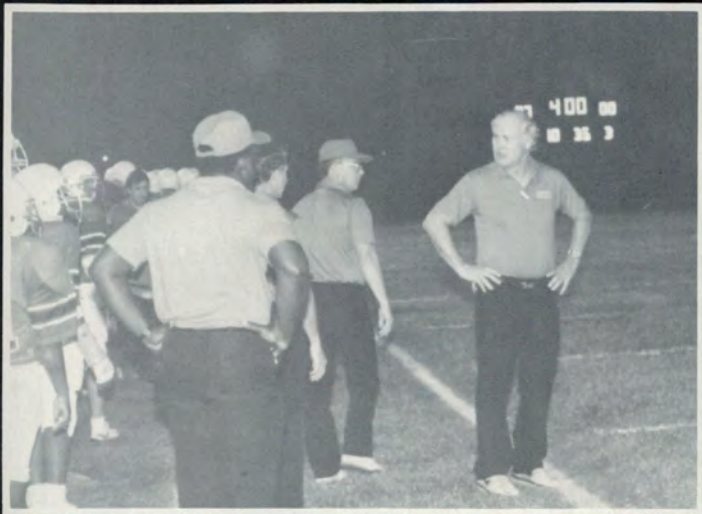
