Student Board Member Report

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Scott Hagerman presented updates to the Board on the following items:

- **Pima County Updates** - COVID levels have decreased substantially and are continuing to move rapidly in a downward direction. Pima County has changed the measurements and categories as seen in the report. We are currently at the Moderate level. The following guidance was issued by Pima County on March 7, 2022:

Schools

1. Will report all suspected or confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 to PCHD.
2. Will report any suspected outbreaks of 3 or more cases.

Pima County Health Department

1. Will conduct case investigation and contact tracing on reported school cases.
2. Will investigate any suspected outbreaks and notify schools when an outbreak is identified.
3. Will provide technical assistance and education regarding mitigation measures in coordination with school staff.

- **20 X 2020 Plan Data** - TVUSD is one of two Pima County school districts which have met the Arizona 20 by 2020 Plan goal. As a reminder, the amount of money we received did not allow us to make this goal, TVUSD made additional investments to meet this goal. We have increased teacher salaries by 20.3%. We continue to invest in teacher salaries in support of student learning as our priority.
- **Logo Update** - At the Board's request, the logo designs are being taken to the ACES, TVES and EGJH Site Councils and a survey is being conducted at each of the schools. The survey closing date is March 11th. We will bring the data to the next board meeting.

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Behavior and Code of Conduct

Beth Egan - EGJH Assistant Principal, Gary Lewis - TVHS Assistant Principal, and Tiffany Hodge - Director of Student Services, presented information on discipline data, the current Code of Conduct, the proposed changes to the Code of Conduct, and discussed the significance of violations of the Code of Conduct.

There was data shared and the recommendations for changes to the Code of Conduct to reflect an optimum balance of expectation, consequences, and restoration for our students within our culture of “Learning with Accountability.” The proposed changes were made based on feedback from the Administrative Leadership Teams. The proposed changes will be reviewed by the Admin Team and the Site Councils before being recommended.

The Goals of the Code of Conduct are as follows:

- TVUSD strives to create a culture of learning with accountability for students who choose not to follow the code of conduct.
- Ensure a balance between being restorative and assuring the quality of education for all students.

Specific language was added regarding telecommunication devices, which is detailed in the report.

Student Learning Update

Dr. Scott Hagerman presented an update on Student Learning to the Board, which included a review of the Four Guiding Questions through which we support and impact student learning:

1. What do we want students to know and be able to do?
2. How do we know if students have learned?
3. How do we respond when students don't learn?
4. How do we respond when students have learned?

Dr. Hagerman shared information regarding our professional learning environment and how we continue to focus on student learning in an appropriate and timely manner to maximize impact and effectiveness. We have been focusing on the first two questions in our initial work, and are now moving into questions three and four with a focus on learning enrichment and interventions.
