This email is being sent as a reminder that if you plan to volunteer for an event during the school year, you must complete the four requirements listed below:

- 1. Attend a parent volunteer presentation given by a Koraes Administrator.
- Fill out and submit to the Koraes office the Koraes Elementary School
  Volunteer Code of Conduct red form
- 2. Submit a serve of vour Driver's Lisense or State ID to the Ke
- 3. Submit a copy of your Driver's License or State ID to the Koraes office
- <u>Register with the Youth Safety Platform</u> This is the link you will need to access to register: <u>https://youthsafetyplatform.goarch.org/</u>

Number 4 in the above requirement list is a mandate through the Greek Archdiocese of America. The background check must be completed every two years. The training with the modules must be completed every year. Unfortunately, If your modules expire during the school year, you will need to have it completed prior to the expiration date.

If you have met this requirement through another parish, you will need to submit proof of certificate to the Koraes School office. The first events this will be required for are the PK4 & Kindergarten field trip to Green Hills Library and hot lunch on September 10th.

Please understand that **you must have all four requirements completed** <u>at</u> <u>least five days prior to the event you are volunteering for</u> to be eligible to volunteer at Koraes Elementary. We sincerely thank all of you for your support and generous hearts!
