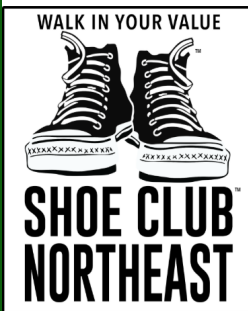
----- Yearbook Club -----

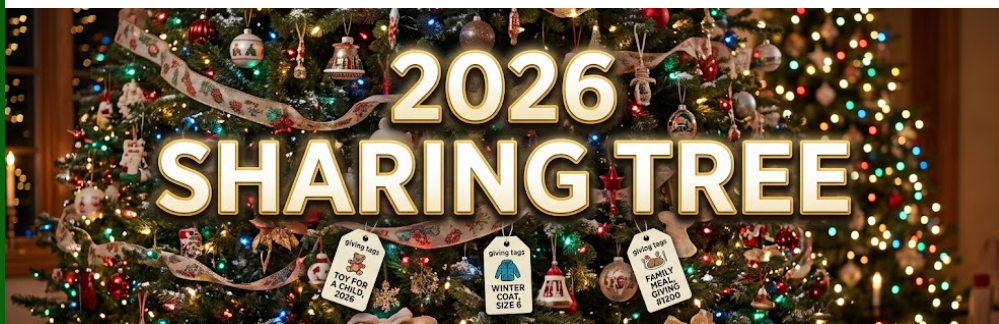


Picture Day forms were passed out last week. If you are not ordering online (below link/code) and need a new form we have extras in the main office.

Inspiring Excellence

This school year, Midland Public Schools is implementing a new bus attendance system to enhance student safety and security.

Elementary students who ride an MPS bus will receive a small tag attached to their backpack, while secondary students will use their district-issued

student ID. Drivers will scan the tag or ID as students board and exit, creating a quick and accurate record of bus ridership.

Good to know: The system does not track student locations, use GPS, or provide real-time tracking. It simply records when students board and exit the bus.

----- Food Service Information -----

Universal free breakfast and lunch will be provided to all MPS students for the 2026-2027 school year. However, if your student wants something that is not part of the free lunch they will need to pay for it with their student ID (which will pull funds from their [SchoolPay](#) lunch account). ----- Immunizations -----

ATTENTION PARENTS OF 7TH GRADE STUDENTS:

Michigan law requires that all students be immunized against vaccine preventable diseases to attend Northeast Middle School. When a student enters 7th grade, the immunization requirements change. Please be sure your student is up-to-date.

The deadline for immunizations is November 1, 2026, but appointments with the Health Department become increasingly difficult to secure as the deadline approaches. The typical immunization update requirements for 7th graders include a booster to Tdap and the meningitis vaccine.

NOTE: Any parent/guardian who wants to claim a non medical waiver will need to receive education regarding the benefits of vaccination and the risks of disease from a county health department before obtaining the certified nonmedical waiver form through the Local Health Department. The new rule requires the use of the State of Michigan non medical waiver form dated January 1, 2017.



Attention Parents

All middle school students must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian in order to enter/attend high school athletic events. Families are also reminded that students are held to the [MPS Student Code of Conduct](#) at any school-sponsored event and at any time they are on school property.
