

## Weekly Announcements September 20-24

It is Spirit Week at Furlow Charter School, and it is currently set to be just the second full week of classes since the first week of school (we have had every other week shortened or disrupted). There will be a pep rally Friday afternoon and themed dress up days every other day of the week.

Here is what we will be studying this week:

### **World History**

We will be having a Gallery Walk on Monday to review and learn about as much as we can regarding Greek and Roman Culture. Then will move on to an activity where we will learn about the important people identified by the Social Studies standards (Socrates, Plato, Aristotle, Alexander the Great, Julius Caesar, and Caesar Augustus. We will be finishing out the week looking at the spread of Christianity and maybe we will get to the Fall of Rome.

### **Government**

We will start the week looking at the division of powers set up in the Constitution between state and national governments. We will then look at the concept of popular sovereignty and how the Constitution was ratified.

### **United States History**

To start, we will look at the problems that the army and the country had at the start of the Revolutionary War. We will then look as a class at the roles played by different groups of people in the war, before finishing off looking at the major battles.

### **Economics**

On Monday we will review the work from last week before looking at the assembly line and the concept of specialization. There will be a test on the introductory unit on Wednesday before moving on to microeconomics and the concepts of Supply and Demand.
