Who is invited:

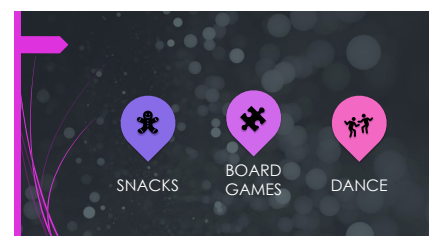
- ▶ Only currently enrolled Thunderbolt students are invited to attend.
- ▶ The dance will cost \$5.00 per ticket. Student council will sell tickets at the front entrance February 5th-9th. We will deliver your ticket (with your first and last name, and 6th period) to your 6th period on February 10th.
- ▶ Only students having fewer than 4 referrals this school year are allowed to attend. Students suspended (ISS/OSS) the day of the dance will not be permitted to attend.
- ▶ Students must be present from 8:00-2:35 on the day of the dance. You may not miss school, then come to the activity.

Important Information:

- ▶ Water and cookies will be provided
- ▶ Cell Phones must be checked in at the library, and are not allowed otherwise
- ▶ Backpacks, purses, etc. are not allowed. Make sure you have done your hair/make-up/body spray at home.

Important Information, cont'd:

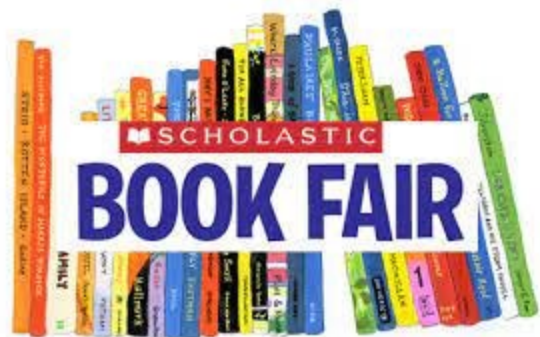
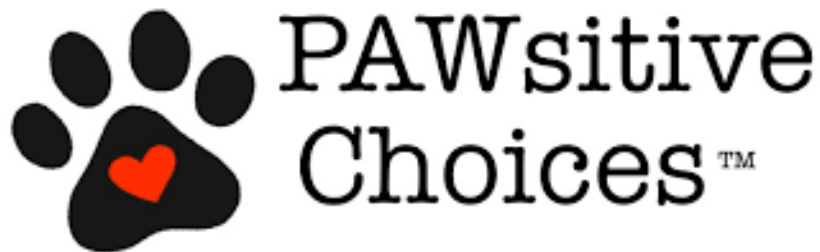
- ▶ The dance is from 5:30-7:30.

- NO GUM IS ALLOWED. If students are caught with gum it will result in an automatic detention.



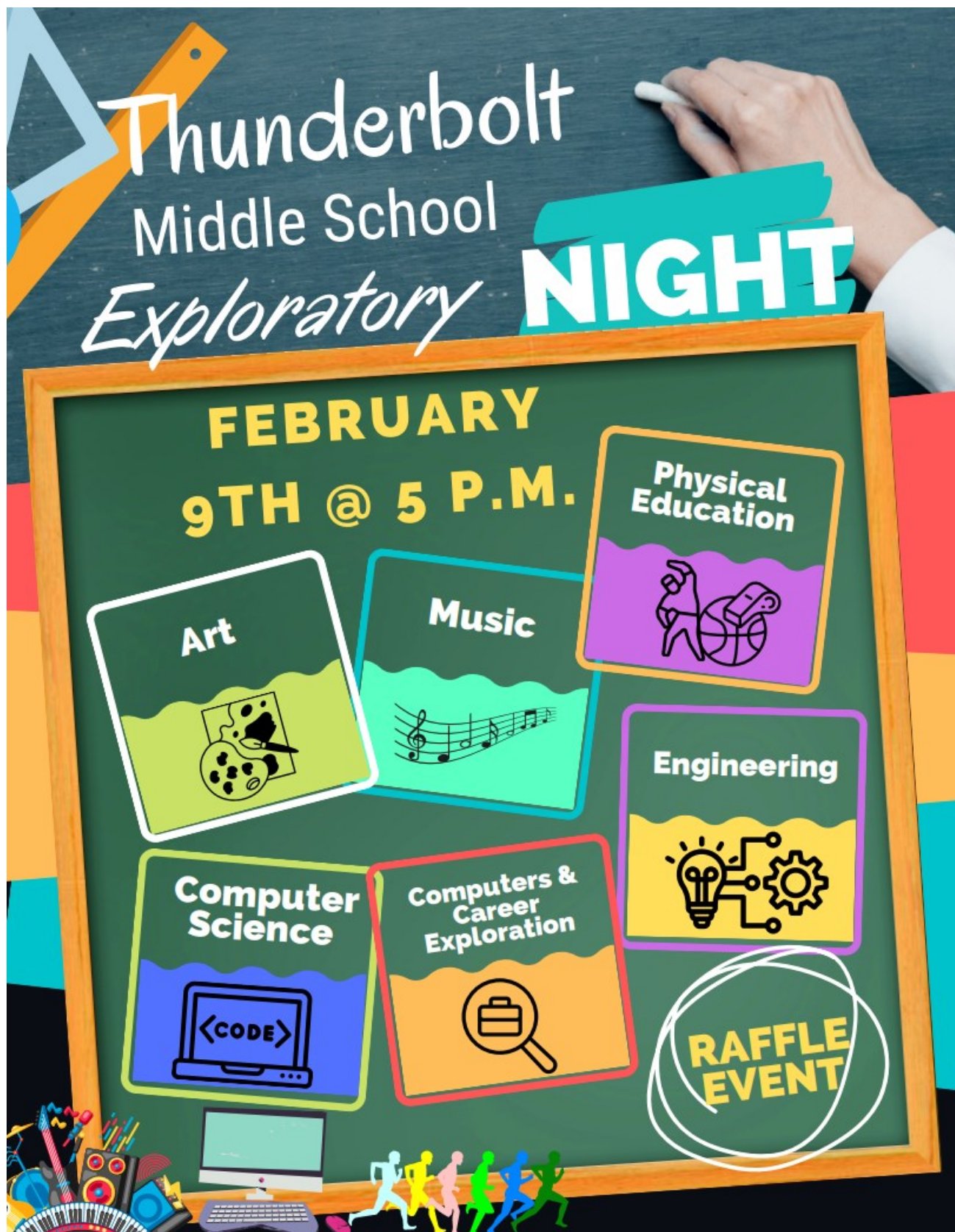
