Homeroom Teacher: Ms. Brooke Sorrells

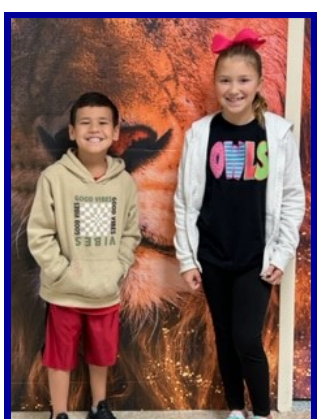
Aubrianna works hard in class every day. She is always willing to help out her classmates.
