Teams Breakdown: Coaches, please note the following meet schedule from previous years. The meet will be broken into 1A-5A teams competing on DAY 1 (Tuesday) and 6A-7A teams competing on DAY 2 (Wednesday).

Day 1 (Tuesday) teams are: Chickasaw, Cottage Hill, Faith Academy, LeFlore, Mobile Christian, B.C. Rain, St. Luke's, Satsuma, Vigor and Williamson.

Day 2 (Wednesday) teams are: Baker, Blount, Bryant, Citronelle, Davidson, McGill-Toolen, MGM, Murphy, Saraland, St. Paul's, Theodore and UMS-Wright.

Awards: • Team Trophies − 1st & 2nd Place Girls and Boys

• Medals - 1st & 2nd place individual and relay members in each division.

Dressing: There will be no dressing rooms or showers; however, restrooms will be available. **Concessions:** There will be a concession stand at the meet.

In order to provide coaches and athletes with a championship environment, these guidelines will apply:

- 1. A rolling time schedule will be used. Athletes must report and check in on time.
- 2. Each team is allowed 3 entries per individual event and 1 relay team. In the throws and horizontal jumps, athletes will have 4 throws / jumps. No prelims. Only finals.
- 3. ALL events and relays, will be "Finals on Time" format (no prelims).
- 4. Athletes must adhere to all AHSAA rules.
- 5. Javelin approach will be on GRASS this year. Athletes may wear cleats as desired.
- 6. Each school will be assigned a meet duty. Please have 1 competent person available from each school.
- 7. Please ensure that your athletes DO NOT JUMP OVER FENCES at the meet. That type of behavior may result in being asked to leave.
