

Motor Vehicle Records (MVR) Waiver

MVR Driving Records Will Only be Run Under the Following Conditions

- 1) Employees who drive a Dyersburg City School vehicle in the course of their job. (i.e., custodial, maintenance, cafeteria staff, etc.)
- 2) Employees who drive a Dyersburg City School vehicle or a personal vehicle in the course of their job, or in a volunteer capacity that includes driving students, and/or adults. (i.e., chaperoning field trips, driving coworker's to and from conferences, etc.)
- 3) Volunteers who drive students in their personal vehicles.

Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) Review

Dyersburg City Schools will obtain an initial Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) from each eligible employee/volunteer who meets the above criteria. This will be required before the driving assignment. This record will be run annually for the period the employee/volunteer is eligible.

Driver Eligibility

Drivers must hold a valid driver's license appropriate for the vehicle, meet district age requirements, be insurable, and successfully pass an MVR review.

Disqualifying Violations

Driving record will be unacceptable under the following conditions:

- 1) Driver has had one or more of the following major violations in the last 3 years:
 - a) DUI/DWI
 - b) Reckless driving
 - c) Hit and run driving
 - d) Driving with a suspended license
 - e) Negligent homicide arising out of the use of a motor vehicle
 - f) Using a motor vehicle for the commission of a felony
 - g) Aggravated assault with a motor vehicle
 - h) Permitting an unlicensed person to drive
 - i) Speeding 20mph or more over the speed limit
- 2) Driving record will be unacceptable if a driver has two or more at-fault accidents in the last 3 years.
- 3) Driving record will be unacceptable if the driver has any combination of at-fault accidents and minor violations which equal three or more in the last three years. Minor violations are any moving violations that are not listed above.

Employee/Volunteer Responsibilities

Drivers must report license changes, violations, or accidents immediately and comply with Tennessee traffic laws and district policies.

If one of the three conditions outlined above are met, I give my permission for Dyersburg City Schools to run my MVR driving record. I understand if none are met, my driving records will not be processed.
