# **COVID Vaccine Clinic Information**

#### **Morning Drop Off**

Please be courteous, slow down, and follow the flow of the traffic. Please do not cut in the line ahead of the other parents patiently waiting in stadium parking to proceed up to the designated drop off areas.

• Upper Lot (Grades 5-8) Please use the entire circle during morning drop off. Please note: in the shaded area 10 cars can fit in the circle to unload students (see image below). Students will exit vehicles proceeding along the designated sidewalk to the front doors.



## **Afternoon Pick Ups**

Please be aware that Pre-K cars are instructed to drive through the Lower Lot (Grades K-4 lot) before 2:35 to pick up the Pre-K students at the primary doors. Pre-School dismissal is staggered and begins at 2:30 and 2:35. Please keep a watchful eye on the cars and pedestrians proceeding through this area. For everyone's safety, no traffic should be proceeding through the highlighted area in the photo below after 2:45.



• Additionally, for the safety of the students during afternoon pickup, siblings and students should not be running or playing around in the grassy area, between cars, or in the cemetery (wooded area).

#### Cafeteria Reminders

- Please remember online lunch orders are due on Sunday evening for the following week.. <u>Order Lunch for November</u>. <u>We encourage families to use the online ordering system in My School Bucks store</u>. Thank you for your cooperation and support!
- Please bring water bottles and morning snacks from home. Students are not permitted to go to the
  cafeteria to purchase these items every day. Please note, SJRCS has water refilling
  stations. Students are permitted to carry clear water bottles each day.
- Reminder, SJRCS is a peanut-free nut-free school. Lunches and snacks must remain nut free.
- Students, staff, teachers, and parents miss having the opportunity to eat lunch in the Cafeteria. Starting on December 1st, on a trial basis between Thanksgiving and Christmas one grade level at each lunch shift will return to the cafeteria to eat lunch with an opportunity to purchase a la carte items and snacks. Based on feedback this plan could continue into the new year and be modified based on COVID guidelines as necessary. The students will be spaced out accordingly at tables (6 students per table), as well as assigned seating to comply with guidelines and assist with contact tracing if necessary. Students will be required to wear their masks when getting up from their table in

- the cafeteria for any reason. Students must sanitize their hands before accessing the snack table and upon entering the kitchen.
- Parent volunteers will be requested to assist with the snack table and disinfecting tables between grade levels. We will accept cash or on-account purchases at the snack table as well as a la carte. Parents will need to instruct their children what is and is not permitted for them to purchase at the snack table...volunteers and staff are not able to restrict purchases.

#### **Face Mask Reminder**

Each student should have two spare face masks in their backpack at all times.

This is a reminder that cloth face coverings should be:

- solid-colored or printed made with at least 2 layers of breathable material
- fit snugly and comfortably against the side of the face (cover nose, mouth, and secure under the chin)
- masks with inappropriate or political messages or innuendos are not permitted
- neck gaiters, open-chin triangle bandanas, and containing valves, mesh material, or holes of any kind are not acceptable.
