- 6. Please include
 - a. A copy of your transcripts with current GPA
 - b. 2 letters of recommendations
 - c. A wallet size picture of yourself (head and shoulders shot)
- 7. YOU MUST be able to attend the "Racing Scholarship Recognition Night" at the Whittemore Speedway in July. Dates will be given to the recipients once applicants have been selected.
 - a. The Whittemore Speedway Scholarship Committee will notify the recipients of the scholarships and their High School Counselor or Principal.
 - b. The scholarship will be made out directly to the recipient.
 - c. The scholarship will be awarded once the recipient has completed the first semester of college and submits a transcript with a GPA of 2.5 or higher to receive scholarship funds.
