HCCA Dual Enrollment (Career Academy)

Houston County Career Academy is an extension of the programs of high schools in Houston County located at an off-campus center of Central Georgia Technical College.

On Campus Dual Enrollment (College Courses Taken at Perry High School)

- Juniors and Seniors who meet the admission requirements for Central Georgia Technical College must enroll in the following dual enrollment courses:
- DE US History I and DE US History II
- DE Economics
- DE Sociology
- DE English 1101

Each course is taught on the Perry High School campus. Students do not leave campus.

College Campus Dual Enrollment (Off Campus Courses)

- Dual Enrollment (DE)
 - Taught on college campuses or online according to college schedule
 - Students are released from high school 2 periods for each college class and required to make a
 yearlong commitment to attending classes for those release periods (minimum 2 college classes 1 per
 semester)
 - Students are responsible for admissions, transportation and all communication with faculty during enrollment
 - Course grades do not exceed 100
 - Withdrawing from a college course could result in a Z code on the transcript
 - College credit is awarded upon successful completion of the course
 - Registration completed outside of Evening Advisement



To Be Eligible:

- Any student attending a public or private high school in Georgia or an eligible home study program
- Must be approved and classified as eligible by the high school
- No residency or citizenship requirement
- Students must sign an advisement form with their high school

- Meet admissions requirements at postsecondary institution
- Must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress as required by the college or university
- Must not have already received a high school diploma



Things to Consider

For every **college** class a student takes, he/she will be released for **two periods** of the high school schedule

Grade Level Eligibility

• Students who are enrolled and physically attending a participating eligible public or private high school in Georgia or an eligible participating home study program in Georgia may participate.

• 11th & 12th Graders


Eligible students may take any approved Dual Enrollment courses listed on the Course Directory, at an eligible participating postsecondary institution (USG, TCSG or private).

10th Graders

Ear a minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration, may enroll in any approved courses listed on the Course Directory at a TCSG, USG or private eligible participating postsecondary institution.

• Students in the <u>9th grade are not eligible</u> to participate in the Dual Enrollment funding Program.
