## Guardian Catholic COVID-19 Report Line 904-705-3827

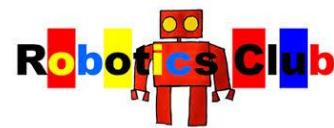
### Your partnership is key and will help us stop widespread community quarantining.
