Step 1-Identifying Struggling Schools August 2022- Step 2-Providing Intensive Support Beginning August 2023, Step 3- Accountability and State Academic Intervention-Beginning August 2026. In addition, we are proud to offer the 4HClub for our 4th and 5th graders and the GREAT Program through the Sheriff's Office for our 5th graders.

<u>Arrival and Dismissal/Safety/Lockdown</u> In order to accomplish our goals, students must arrive on time for school daily.
