Dear North Canaan Elementary School Parents and Guardians,

North Canaan Elementary School has recently encountered an increased population of bees on school grounds, primarily in the area of AHA and the art room. The bees have created a serious disruption to student safety at our school, resulting in numerous bee stings over the last few days.

In order to address this situation, we have contacted a Connecticut Licensed Applicator to spray Drione Insecticide Dust for bees. The application will occur in the courtyard area outside the cafeteria early tomorrow morning when no students are on campus. When applied according to product instructions, Drione Insecticide Dust is safe to use around children and pets.

We take student safety very seriously here at North Canaan Elementary School, and desire to take the appropriate measures to remedy this matter.
