This assessment is designed to ensure that students with significant cognitive disabilities are provided access to the state academic content standards and given the opportunity to demonstrate achievement of the knowledge, concepts, and skills inherent in the standards.

The GAA 2.0 will be administered to all eligible students in the following areas:

- Grades 3-8 and high school will be assessed in English Language Arts and Mathematics.
- Grades 5, 8, and high school will be assessed in Science.
- Grades 8 and high school will also be assessed in Social Studies.

Students must report to the building for testing. No diagnostic assessments will be administered virtually.

Testing will begin promptly at 8:30AM daily. It is very important that each child is present each day for testing.

Reminder: Coats, jackets/hoods, book bags, cell phones, smart watches, air pods and/or any other electronic communication devices are prohibited in the testing environment.
