Be it resolved that the Demarest Board of Education "District" accepts the Food Service Management proposal from The Pomptonian, Inc. "FSMC" to manage the food service operation for the remainder of the 2025 school year and the 2025-2026 school year. The fee for service will remain the same through June 2026.

The FSMC shall receive, in addition to the costs of operation, a management fee of \$.0522 for each \$1.00 of sales to compensate the FSMC for administrative and management costs. This fee shall be billed monthly as a cost of operation. The District guarantees the payment of such costs and fee to the FSMC.
