5. **voice**: an opinion, wish, or choice that someone is allowed to express
6. **right**: something that someone is allowed to have morally or legally
7. **symbol**: something that stands for an idea
8. **democracy**: a government that is run by the people who live under it
9. **emigrated**: to leave one's own place or country and live in another
10. **immigrated**: to come to live in a country where one was not born
11. **oath**: a statement or a promise in which a person swears that what he or she said is true
12. **traits**: quality of a person or animal
