

FROM DEACON REX RE THE EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION ON SATURDAY, MAY 17, 2025, FROM ST. PHILIP TO ST. ANDREW

We are so very happy that you have registered to join your brothers and sisters from St. Therese Church to be part of the Pasadena Eucharistic Revival Procession **TOMORROW, Saturday, May 17**. Below are the critical details to help you plan for the procession.

The Procession Route (distance: 2 miles)

- 4 PM: Park at PCC in "Lot 3" at the corner of Hill Ave. & Del Mar Blvd. Parking is free for this event
- 5 PM: Mass at St. Philip the Apostle, celebrated by Archbishop Gomez with Fr. Peter Mary & Fr. Stephen concelebrating
- 6 PM: Procession begins
- 6:30 PM: Benediction station at Pasadena City Hall
- 7 PM: Final Benediction at St. Andrew Catholic Church
- 7:30 PM: Refreshments/food trucks available

Where do we gather before the procession?

- BEFORE MASS, please pick up your NAME BADGE at the driveway directly north of the entrance to St. Philip's. Then, AFTER the 5:00 pm Mass at St. Philip, return to that spot to gather in order to start the procession together. The location should be easy to identify because there will be volunteers there with the carrier of the relic of St. Therese along with her statue.
- This will be the departure point to join the procession. Please make it to this location as quickly as possible after the Mass – the procession starts immediately, and we all want to be together if possible.

Procession Tips

- Arrive early.
- Wear comfortable shoes.
- Stay hydrated – consider bringing a water bottle.
- Bring a "buddy" in case you need to take a break along the way. We don't want anyone left behind alone.
- It will be partially cloudy and cool on Saturday. Please layer appropriately for the walk. (Sunset is at 7:50 pm)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- Is space limited?
- Space at Mass is limited in the church, but there is additional overflow space in St. Philip's Parish Office if needed. We suggest you arrive early.
- There is no limit to the number of people who can participate in the Eucharistic Procession.
- We have approximately 200 people joining from St. Therese, but we have no idea how many total participants there will be in the procession. Please be flexible and understanding, as we need to be considerate of everyone as we come together to celebrate Our Lord in this beautiful witness of faith.

If I can't attend the Mass, can I still participate in the procession?

ABSOLUTELY! Please join us for all or part of the procession, including joining us for Benediction in front of the Pasadena City Hall.

What time do I need to arrive?

St. Philip the Apostle Church will be open at 4 PM. Because of limited space for Mass, we suggest arriving as early as you can. There will also be space available outside the Church.

Where can I park?

- Parking will be available at the Pasadena City College parking lot 3 at the corner of Hill Ave. and Del Mar Blvd. Visit this campus map for more details.
- Please note, the church's parking lot will be closed for logistics and a separate event. Please park only at PCC lot 3 or on the street. Do not attempt to park in the St. Philip's church parking lot unless you have been directed to.

How do we get back; is transportation provided?

After the procession, there will be shuttles available to transport pilgrims back to St. Philip the Apostle church/PCC.

What if I get tired or thirsty along the way?

- There will be a water station in front of Target on Colorado Blvd.
- The procession will be reverent and will not move very quickly. That said, it will not be stopping until it reaches Pasadena City Hall.

What happens after we reach St. Andrews?

- There will be a final Benediction.
- After the procession, you are welcome to gather outside the church for a time of fellowship.
- There will be food trucks for you to purchase refreshments if you would like.
- Two buses will be running continuously bringing people back to St. Philips/PCC to pick up their cars.
