According to the World Health Organization, millions of children worldwide don't have access to eye care



~312 million

children have myopia, with half remaining undetected and untreated



~19 million

children have visual impairments that cannot be corrected by corrective lenses



3 out of 4

of these children live in Asia and Africa with a lack of access to treatment for preventable or treatable conditions
