## **ALTERNATIVE CREDIT OPTIONS**

Credit may be earned through alternative methods outside of regular classroom-based instruction. Such alternative methods could include but not limited to, transfer of credits from prior school enrollments, current sending districts, career and technical education centers, and credit earned through placements. Awarding of credit to be applied toward high school graduation will be determined by the Center Director and Principal.

Students earning credit via alternative methods will participate in all assessments required by North Country Charter Academy and NH Department of Education.

## **Funding**

Unless otherwise recommended by the Superintendent and approved by the Board, under ordinary circumstances, students or their parents/guardians are responsible for all related expenses including tuition and textbooks.
