## **Governing Board Meeting Summary**

The November 2, 2021 Governing Board Meeting was held with topics including the Superintendent's Report and a Student Learning Update presentation by our Elementary School Leadership Team. In addition, there were many comments received and read from the in-person and virtual call to the public. There were no action items appearing on the agenda.

## Reports to the Board

Student Board Member, Lilyana Brummitt presented the <u>Student Board Report</u>, which focused on activities at Tanque Verde High School and Agua Caliente Elementary School.

Dr. Scott Hagerman presented information on the <u>Aggregate Expenditure Limits</u>, the <u>ADE Aggregate Expenditure Report</u>, and high school student club and sports end of season successes which are included in the Board Acknowledgments.

### Information and Discussion Items

Elementary principals, Chris Rietz and Emma Batty, provided an update on the enVision Math Implementation for the elementary schools.

## Pima County Health Department Recommends Closure of Agua Caliente Elementary School Until November 15th

Tanque Verde Unified School District's Agua Caliente Elementary School has been closed for 10 days through the recommendation of the Pima County



Health Department, due to the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases and the percentage of students absent at the school over the past two days. Three classrooms had already been closed prior to the school closure. Students will be able to access their learning virtually during the closure. The order is in effect until November 15, 2021.

Agua Caliente Elementary School (ACES) is currently the only TVUSD school under the Pima County Closure Order. Detailed information was sent to ACES staff/families about the closure yesterday afternoon. An InTouch Emergency Telephone Notification was also made to ACES families.

Parents/ACES staff will continue to receive email communication from the school with important updates and information. A Chromebook drive-thru pick-up was held at ACES to assist families with devices for remote learning. The Grab and Go Pick Up Meal Service continues to be available to ALL children at Tanque Verde High School.

The Tanque Verde Unified School District Governing Board, in a <u>letter to the TVUSD Community dated October 22, 2021</u>, had previously noted the increasing numbers of cases in the district's schools and asked for continued cooperation with the schools' COVID-19 Mitigation Protocols. They implored everyone "to work together with kindness and respect." At the November 2nd Board Meeting, there was a board request made to add a future action item on the implementation of a mask mandate. A Special Board Meeting may be scheduled, or it may be addressed at the next regular board meeting on November 17th.

#### ACES information from PCHD:

- Unvaccinated individuals should quarantine for a period of 10 full days.
- Vaccinated individuals, if asymptomatic, do not need to quarantine but should test for COVID-19 from Saturday, Nov. 6, to Monday, Nov. 8.
- If an individual tests <u>positive</u> for COVID-19, they should contact the school, wait for the quarantine period to end, and then get the vaccine, or if they are

eligible, get a booster.

• If an individual in quarantine (unvaccinated) has a <u>negative</u> test result, they can get the vaccine without delay.

Current Ages 5-11 vaccine information is available as of Wednesday, November 3rd. CVS and Walgreens are scheduling now for first shots starting Sunday 11/7. Pima County will start scheduling soon. Tanque Verde Pediatrics will have a shot clinic on November 13-14.

Grab & Go pick-up time is Monday through Friday 9 a.m.-10 a.m. at Tanque Verde High School.

Children do not have to be enrolled in TVUSD to receive free meals and parents/guardians are allowed to pick-up meals without the children being present. All children on campus will be offered a free breakfast and free lunch.


