Centennial BOCES Plan for Safe Return

The plan was created in March 2020 at the onset of Covid-19 and is reviewed based on updated CDE Guidelines as well as the Colorado Department of Health updates. The plan is also reviewed every three months or before, as needed.

In-Person and/or Remote Options

Centennial BOCES High School started offering remote option in March 2020 and continues to offer remote for students that are not ready to return in person yet.

Social, Emotional, Mental, and other Needs

Centennial BOCES High School has access to a social worker, psychologist, and mental health professionals that are employed by CBOCES and support CBHS students.

Layered Prevention Strategies

Centennial BOCES High School follows the prevention strategies listed below to prevent the spread of Covid-19:

- Consistent and Correct Mask Use
- Physical Distancing
- Daily temperature taking for students and staff
- Ventilation
- Handwashing and Respiratory Etiquette
- Staying Home when Sick/Getting Tested
- Contact Tracing
- Cleaning and Disinfection

Phased Prevention
