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### TK and Kindergarten

Kindergarten students reviewed the letters they learned. They are practicing finding and reading CVC words using the sounds. They are learning how to put a finger space in between words when they write and draw a picture that matches the phrase.

Kindergarten is working on adding two numbers. Students are using manipulatives to help identify two numbers that equal the whole number. They are learning how to read number sentences and find the missing number in an addition sentence.

TK students are learning about animals and their basic needs. They are learning about the different characteristics of animals and what they need to survive. TK is learning the letters in their names and practicing how to write their names. They are also working on counting syllables in words.

TK students are learning about shapes. They will learn to identify, sort, describe, and create 2D shapes.
