Janssen moved, seconded by Egge to adopt the resolution directing superintendent to make recommendations for adjustments in curriculum. Voting in favor: Egge, Fest, Hendel, Janssen, Rasche and Volk. Against: none. The motion carried.

A fundraiser for Coyote Basketball camp for PK-3<sup>rd</sup> graders was brought up. They were planning on Wednesday nights, but the school has tried to avoid Wednesday night activities due to church. No action was taken to approve this fundraiser.
