KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

An informational meeting to update parents on how to register for upcoming kindergarteners for the 2022-23 school year will will be held on March 1, 2022 at 6:00PM in our gymnasium. All parents will have access to registration forms that night or via our website. Parents will need to fill out all forms. Our office may call parents to follow up on obtaining any remaining records such as birth certificates, proof of residency, and immunizations that will need to be submitted. They will also set up times for screenings in May.

If you know other people who will have a Kindergartner here please help us spread the word about this. There will be an informative PPT shared and schedules will be discussed at that time. Students should be five years of age on or before September 1, 2022 to register. Students who are not of this age by December will receive added screenings for academic and social readiness and will only be admitted once readiness has been determined by staff and admin.

There will also be a Kinder bootcamp this summer for students who may need support coming into kindergarten. More information to come.
