### **School Attorney**

### Credit Card Need

SGSC is in need of a credit card to make purchases online and at stores that do not have accounts set up for billing. This has been an ongoing issue, but Mrs. Wilson has been in contact with Charity Charge to gain a secured credit card. It appears that we may have this in place by the end of January 2023.

### Staff Attendance Incentives

We will plan to reward those staff members with perfect attendance for the first half of the school year with a \$100 gift card for their efforts. There are 6 people eligible for this reward.

### **Bus Purchase**

As enrollment continues to grow, there is evidence of a need for an additional bus for the 23-24 school year. Our buses are almost all at max capacity now - even with two buses in Cuthbert and Dawson to help with the overflow. Mrs. Wilson will begin contacting Brantley Sims to see if there are any used buses available for purchase in the near future.

### **Enrollment Summary**

As of December 15, 2022 - there are 475 students enrolled at SGSC - 29% non-white students. Diversity is always a focus and we are seeing small increases of diversity over time.
