



Recruiting Plan

Admission Policy: The P-TECH recruitment and enrollment processes will consider all students but will strategically identify, recruit, and enroll the subpopulations of at-risk students (as defined by PEIMS). These students may include those with limited English proficiency, those with disabilities, or those who have failed a state administered assessment. Enrollment decisions shall not be based on passing state assessment scores, teacher recommendation, parent or student essays, minimum grade point average (GPA), or other criteria that create barriers for student enrollment. Por Vida Academy at Corpus Christi's P-TECH program shall also identify, recruit, and enroll subpopulations (in addition to at-risk students) that are historically underrepresented in college. (e.g., first generation college goers, students of low socioeconomic status, or underrepresented ethnicities.) If there are more applications than available space for admission, participants
