- You will be required to work on yearbook pages daily. You will find info for your pages (pictures and body copy) and will submit it on or before the deadline.
- All information regarding the yearbook is confidential until it is released in the spring. It is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to ensure that <u>no</u> yearbook information leaves the room.
- Assigned pictures and information for pages are <u>YOUR</u> responsibility. If you cannot attend your assigned event, it is <u>YOUR</u> job to find someone who can.

### Camera Use & Replacement Cost:

By checking out the school cameras, you assume replacement cost (point/click digital cameras: \$50, DSLR: \$300). It is your responsibility to assess the camera for any issues prior to check out. Cameras must be checked in and out by the instructor. 1745 2023-2024

Late Work: You will receive half credit for up to five days after the due date for late assignments.

Yearbook Avenue: To complete the yearbook, we will be using the Jostens platform Yearbook Avenue. All pages for the yearbook will be completed using the tools in this platform. It is vital that you are familiar with how to navigate this site in order to submit your pages on time. You are encouraged to access Yearbook Avenue outside of class and familiarize yourself with its features at the start of the semester. We will have several lessons that will allow you to practice using Yearbook Avenue prior to creating actual yearbook pages, but please explore the platform on your own and bring your questions to the yearbook advisor or one of the editors.

### Accessing Yearbook Avenue:

<u>Step One:</u> Go to yearbookavenue.com

Step Two: Enter the year "2024" and the job number "40689"

<u>Step Three:</u> Your username is your first initial + last name. Your password is your first name + 2024.
