## Kindergarten/Young 5's School Entry

Hearing and vision screening clinics will be on May 12th & 13th

Screenings are free.

If your child has been previously screened between the ages of 3 and Kindergarten Entry and you need a copy of the record call the Heath Department.

Michigan Law requires hearing and vision screening at least once between the ages 3-5 before your child enters kindergarten. The Public Health Code Act 368 of 1978, Section 9307 states that "a parent, guardian, or person in *loco parentis* applying to have a child registered for the first time in a kindergarten or first grade in a school in this state shall present to school officials, at the time of registration or not later than the first day of school, a certificate of hearing and vision testing or screening or statements of exception under Section 9311".
