Students spent Wednesday going to Olympic Junior Programs where our very own Jaice was chosen to be a part of the performance!

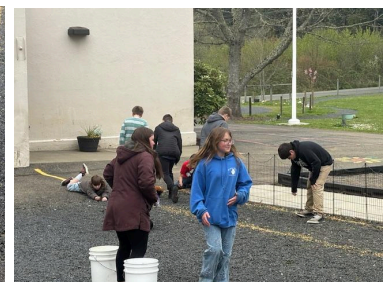
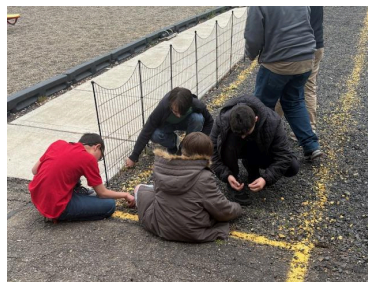


## Fifth and Sixth Grade Classroom
