GOOD NEWS

Everything seems to be going great! Dismissal is getting better. Cars are off Millbrooke Drive and we have had positive feedback from parents. Our Resource officer, Mr. Jerry Marcum says we are safe and secure.

OPENING BUSINESS

- We have practiced our first set of emergency drills school wide.
- The entire school has helped kindergarten students learn their colors by wearing the color of the day.

UPCOMING EVENTS

- On September 4th our 5th grade students will go to the Pow Wow at the Trail of Tears.
- Grandparents will be celebrated on September 4th after school hours. They will be able to tour our building and see all of our new renovations.
- All students will MAP test the first 2 weeks of September. KSA data should be available soon.

STAFFING UPDATES

- We still need a Highly Structured Resource (HSR) Teacher. An HSR para educator, Brandy Spurr, has been hired and should start next week.
- Lee Loggins has started this week as a certified math teacher. Betty Holmes will start next week as a certified reading teacher.
- Scott Hollimon moved from STEAM to 3rd grade Reading this year.
- Kaci Akridge has been hired to teach STEAM.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

- Bryan Lovely painted the letters black on the front of the school.
- Our new learning nooks have arrived and are being used daily.

POLICIES

The council reviewed the AED policy. We have added another AED machine. We now have one located in the cafeteria and one in the gym. The council made no changes to the policy.

The Master Schedule was presented to the council for review. Students will attend school for 395 instructional minutes. A motion was made and approved by consensus to accept this as presented.

Council moved into closed session for discussion of the Emergency Management Response Plan at 3:41. Closed session ended at 3:55. A motion was made and accepted by consensus to accept the Emergency Management Response Plan as presented. This is the first reading.

PRINCIPAL COMMENTS

- Our first fundraiser will begin on September 16th. It is a Fun Run that students sign up for and get prizes for donations.
- We now stand at 100% on our online Registration. We have 601 students enrolled.
