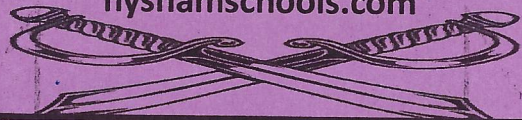

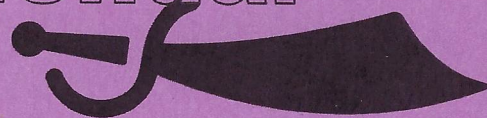

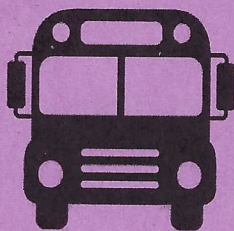

HYSHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT 1 NOTICE OF INTENT TO INCREASE NONVOTED LEVIES MARCH 2024

The Board of Trustees of Hysham School District 1 hereby resolves to consider and adopt the following changes in revenues/mills from Adult Education, Building Reserve Permissive, General Fund, Technology, Transportation, and Tuition funds of the K-12 School District for school fiscal year 2025.

Be it further resolved, that as an essential part of its budgeting process, the Hysham School District Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Hysham School District Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenue and mills for the funds noted below for the next school year beginning July 1, 2024 using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district.

The Board of Trustees continues to evaluate improvements needed to the school facility that include increased energy efficiency, technology enhancements, school safety, the replacement of flooring, and future roof and heating system repairs. The Permissive Levy associated with building improvements is managed through the Building Reserve Fund. The annual amount for the Building Reserve Fund levy is established by formula via OPI.

Impacts above are based on current year 2023-2024 certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year.

Be it resolved that the Hysham School District Board of Trustees approves the resolution of intent to increase/decrease fund levies as presented above for school fiscal year 2024-2025.
