

Temporary Special Education Certificate (TSEC)

(Collaborative Teacher Grades 6-12)

Individuals employed under a Temporary Special Education Certificate (TSEC) serve full-time as a Collaborative Teacher for each period/block of the day. This option is only available in grades 6-12 and must be requested by an employing Alabama county/city superintendent. This is a three year process to attain professional certification.

As part of the TSEC approach, the following will be required to attain professional certification:

- ✓ Completion of five (5) specified courses in the area of Special Education at an Alabama institution approved to offer this coursework. (Enrollment or completion of one (1) course is required for issuance of the first TSEC.)
- ✓ Completion of six (6) specified Special Education Professional Learning activities. (Registration in at least two (2) of the professional learning activities is required for issuance of the 1st TSEC.)
- ✓ Attain passing scores on the Alabama prescribed Praxis subject areas tests.
- ✓ Successful completion of at least four (4) required practical Field Experiences.

Eligibility

To be considered for hire under the TSEC, you must hold at least a bachelor's degree or higher from an appropriately accredited senior institution with an overall GPA of at least 2.5 (3.0 GPA for master's degree or higher).
