School's Responsibility:

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive, effective environment to meet student academic standards and school goals.
- Follow state curriculum standards provided by TDOE.
- Build partnerships through a variety of family oriented activities and provide assistance in understanding academic standards, assessments, and how to monitor your child's progress.
- Provide opportunities for ongoing communication through, at a minimum:
 - Annual parent-teacher conferences
 - Mid-nine week academic progress reports and quarterly report cards
 - The school website, Class Dojo, and social media pages such as X (formerly known as Twitter) and Facebook
 - Two-way communication between family members and school staff and, to the extent practicable, in a language that is understandable
 - Reasonable access to staff, opportunities to volunteer, and observe classroom activities
 - Teacher Class Dojo Accounts

Parent's Responsibility:

- Ensure your child attends school on time and regularly.
- Encourage your child to show positive school behavior.
- Review homework and classwork and offer support when needed.
- Monitor your child's social media presence and time spent on electronic devices.
- Review and sign documents, such as progress reports and report cards.
- Attend parent-teacher conferences.
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of your child.
- Volunteer in your child's school or classroom if time permits.

Student's Responsibility:

- Come to school prepared.
- Complete and return all classwork and homework in a timely manner.
- Provide parents with all notices and information received from the school.
- Be responsible and respectful at all times.
- Ask for help when needed.
