

## Week of: October 23<sup>rd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>

### Theme: Pumpkins

This week will consist of the theme focused on pumpkins. We will be focusing on the letter: G and number: 7 this week. We will learn about the life cycle of a pumpkin, the resources needed to grow a pumpkin, and the difference between a living and nonliving pumpkin. We will read pumpkin themed books. We will have whole group and small groups. Music and movement will consist of singing and dancing to theme related songs. We will attend music class on Wednesday! For science, we will make predictions about if different sized pumpkins will sink or float. We will use our predictions to create a graph. After our sink or float experiment, we will discuss the results and our graph. We will complete a pumpkin art activity! We will paint pumpkins! We will have a fun letter G themed activity! We will work on the following literacy skills: letter identification and letter sounds. We will work on the following math skills: counting, quantifying, number identification, and graphing. We will strengthen our fine motor skills by writing our names, letters, numbers, and working in our journals. We will attend a glow party on Thursday! Ms. Silvey and Mrs. Shoupe will have a glow necklace and bracelet for each of the children. We are looking forward to an awesome Fall Fun Day on Friday! This week will be filled with fun while learning about our letters, numbers, and pumpkins!
