MATH

Students enrolled in Grades 1 through 8 received a summer math skills book.

The Summer Skills Math Book contain 30 to 35 lessons of mixed-skills practice. Children will be exposed to important concepts repeatedly in small doses throughout the summer. The books are meant to be used 3-4 times per week for 10 weeks so that concepts are reinforced from the beginning of summer to the end. Most lessons only take about 20 minutes.
