

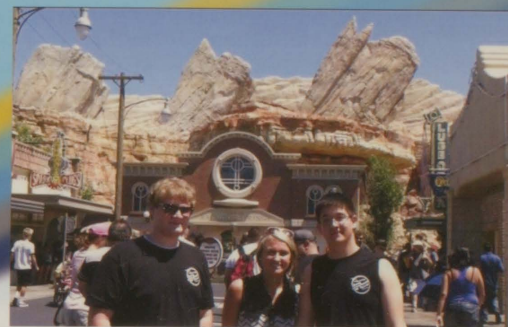
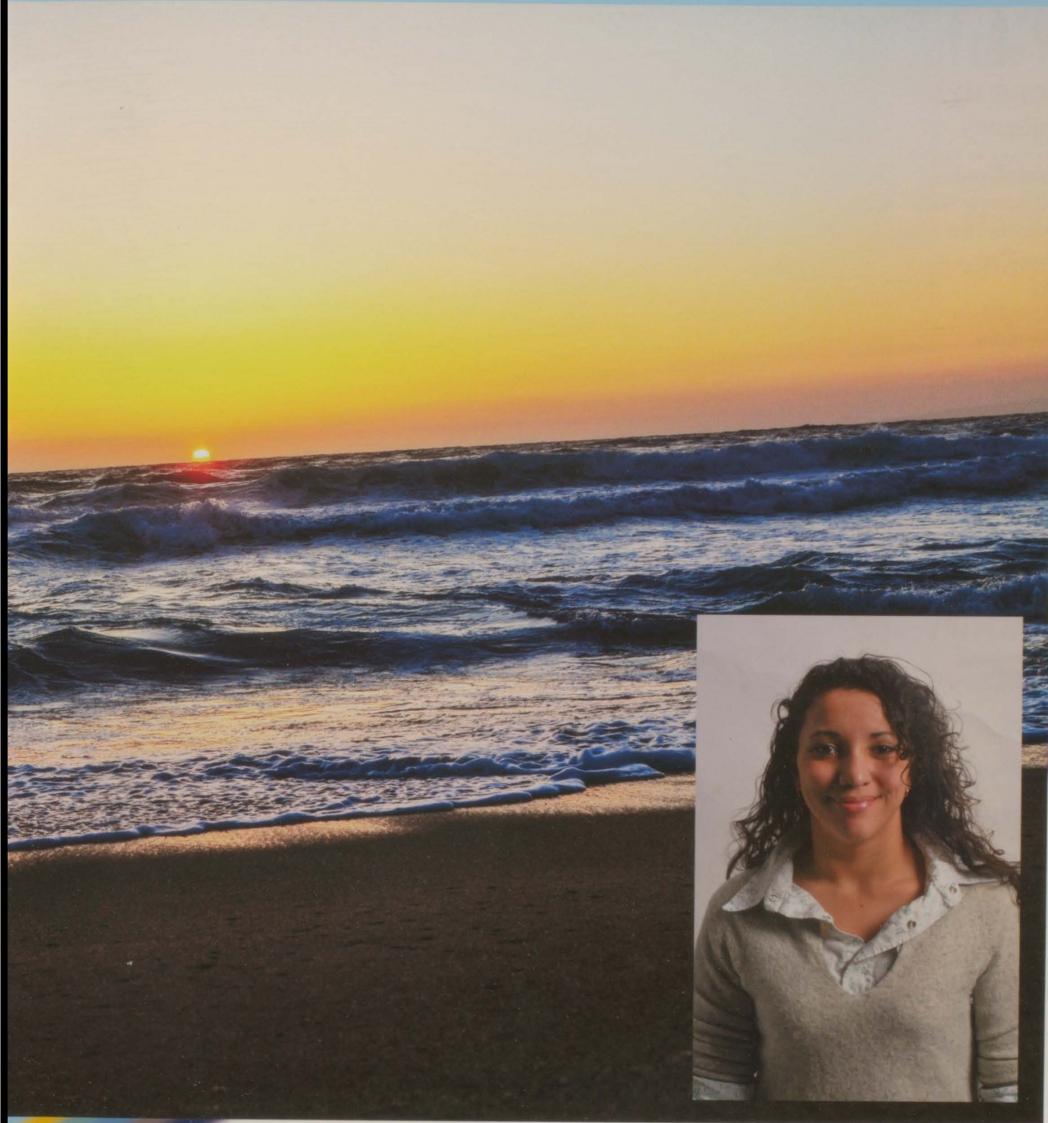


# Atypical

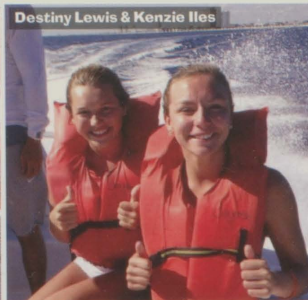
# A typical CCHS student's Summer Activities

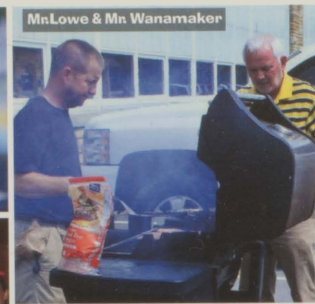
# Tailgating

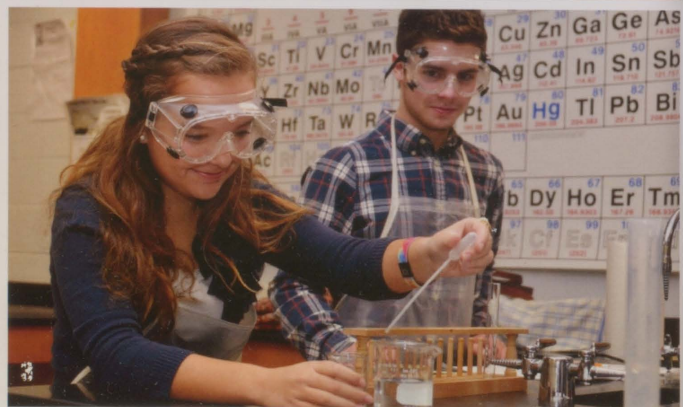




# Experimenting With Science

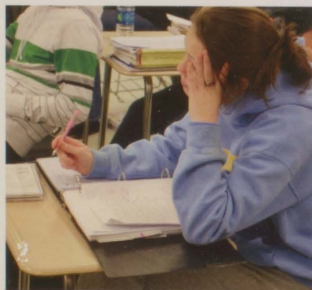




# Looking Into the Past...

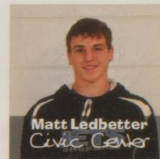
# JV/Freshman Basketball

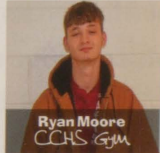

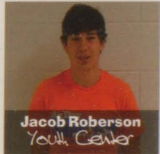

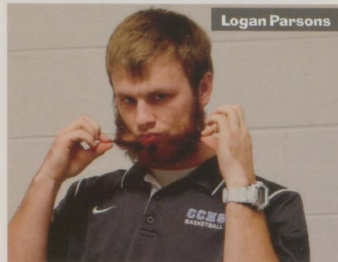
# A typical "No Shave November"

# Use Your Talents

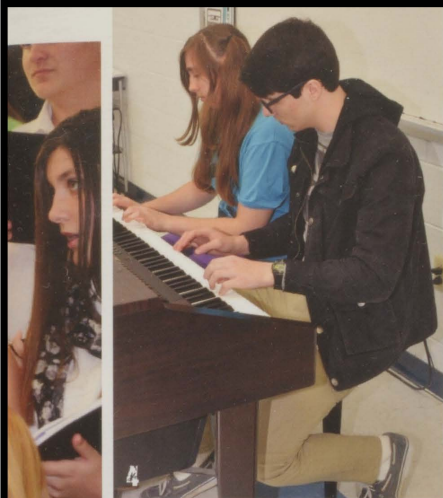

# To Be or Not To Be?

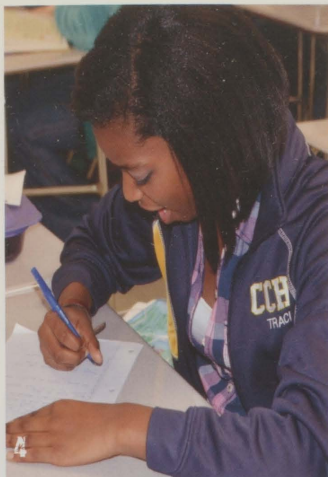
