61% of the class of 2023 (23 graduates) attended a 4-year college, 26% attended a 2-year or vocational college, and 13% entered the workforce.

Colebrook Academy administers the school day SAT exam. This exam was given in March to the Junior Class. 13% met both the English and Math benchmarks, 43 % met the English benchmark and 17% met the math benchmark.

In the fall 4 seniors participated in the SAT with 100% meeting both English and Math benchmarks.

9 Juniors and 4 sophomores participated in the PSAT in October




