JUNIORS AND SENIORS ALSO HAVE THE OPTION TO ATTEND ANY OF THE 5 PROGRAMS OFFERED AT THE CANAAN VT CTE CENTER WHICH INCLUDE: BUILDING TRADES, FIRE SERVICES & EMS, DIVERSIFIED AGRICULTURE, BUSINESS AND ADVANCED INTEGRATED MANUFACTURING. CTE IS STUDENT-ORIENTED AND COMBINES ACADEMIC SKILLS AND TECHNICAL KNOWLEDGE NECESSARY FOR SUCCESS IN TODAY'S WORKFORCE. STUDENTS CAN EARN A VARIETY OF COLLEGE CREDITS AS WELL AS INDUSTRY RECOGNIZED CREDENTIALS.
