College Scholarship Program - *for individuals seeking a career in the human service field*

Sinnissippi Centers recognizes that the field of human services is challenging. We applaud your interest in seeking a career making a difference in the lives of others! Our College Scholarship Program, available exclusively to those who seek education in human services (social work, psychology, sociology or other human service specialties), recognizes and rewards high school seniors on the path to higher education with a \$1,000 scholarship to use towards a full-time or part-time course of study. Sinnissippi Centers will award up to four (4), \$1,000 scholarships in 2026. Complete program details including eligibility and requirements are below.

Eligibility

Scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a 2026 graduating northwest Illinois area high school senior
- Plan to enroll, beginning the fall of 2026, in a full-time or part-time course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year university in Illinois with the declared major being one that falls within the human services field.

Requirements

Applicants must submit all of the following:

- Completed application
- High school transcript - minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 required
- Essay regarding "What A Career in Human Services Means to Me"
 - ~ Include name and address on essay
 - ~ Essay should be 500 words or less, double-spaced, and typed or printed
- Letter of recommendation from one (1) counselor, teacher or other school official

Process

Complete applications received on or before deadline will be considered by a panel of judges comprised of Sinnissippi Centers employees and management. Applications will be judged on academic achievement, letter of recommendation, and essay. Essay and letter of recommendation will be judged on spirit, content, and quality. Course selection and GPA will be the basis for academic achievement consideration.

Please send completed application and corresponding materials to the address below postmarked no later than March 13, 2026. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. All decisions are final. Recipients will be notified via email by April 13, 2026.
