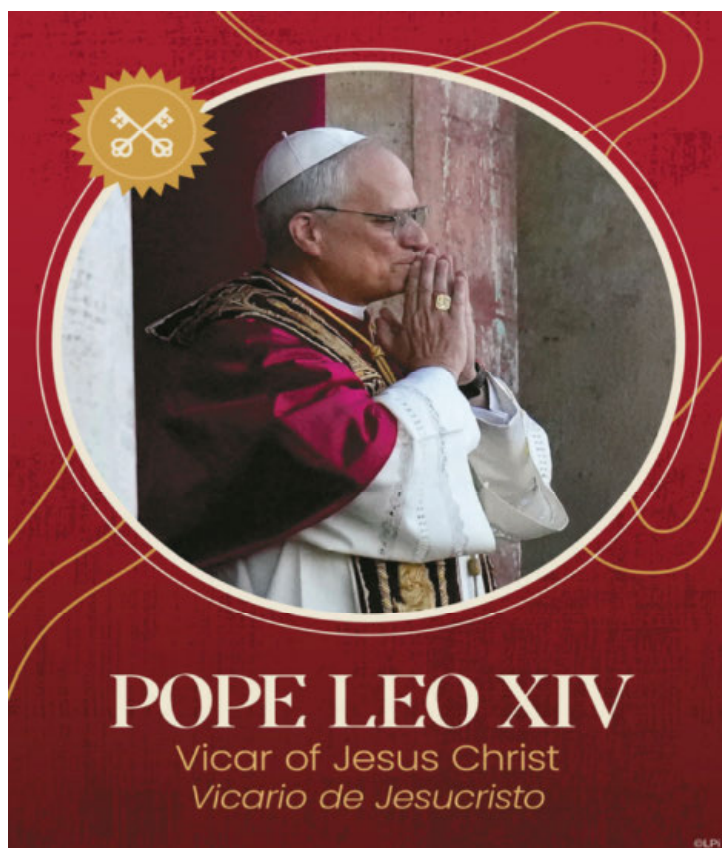

St Margaret of Scotland

**Queen + Mother + Wife +
 Evangelist + Immigrant**

When I was newly appointed to this parish, I was approached by the Knights of Columbus, who asked if I had a special project I could give them. After conversation, we decided that a statue of a saint would be a good idea and they left it to me to suggest which one. After a lot of thought I chose St Margaret of Scotland, who lived from 1045 – 1093. There are many male canonized saints, but fewer women, and married women among the canonized are scarce.



Margaret was born into the English royal family, but was born in exile in Hungary because the royal family had fled from England because of an invasion of the Danes. She returned to England at the age of 10 but soon was forced to flee from the Norman invasion of 1066 which overthrew the Anglo-Saxon House of Wessex. She resolved to turn to the continent where she had relatives, but she was shipwrecked on the coast of Scotland and so sought refuge with Malcom III, King of Scots.

Malcom's first wife had died, and the royal pair soon fell in love and were married in 1070. They spent their lives together, and had eight children. King Malcom was large, loud and very much the warrior, and had earlier slain the usurping King Macbeth. Margaret made it her business to bring some degree of civility to the wild Scottish Royal Court. When Malcom was not out breaking people's heads open, the couple spent the evenings quietly together, while Margaret read him Bible stories, translating the Latin on sight. She used her position to work many charitable acts for the poor, arranged for a bridge to be built for pilgrims visiting local shrines. She was particularly devout, encouraged the clergy to spread the Faith, challenged corruption and founded several churches. She personally cared for the poor in hospitals and she even managed to convince the King to assist personally in feeding programs for the hungry. In 1093, when she was informed of her husband's death in battle, she collapsed and died a few days later. They were buried together in Dunfermline Abbey.

The chronicles tell a wonderful story, that her grave had become so popular that the site was difficult for pilgrims, and so the monks resolved to build her a larger shrine. But when the time came to transfer her remains, they dug up the saint's casket without problem, but once placed on the floor, it absolutely would not move no matter how hard they pushed and pulled. Soon, they saw the problem, that King Malcom had not been exhumed with his wife. So they dug him up also and the royal couple was moved together.

St Margaret is called "the pearl of Scotland" and is the patron saint of expectant mothers, particularly those with troubled pregnancies, nurses and those who call to her from their deathbed. Her feast day is November 16.

I want to express my deep thanks to the Knights of Columbus for their generosity in making this gift to Sacred Heart.

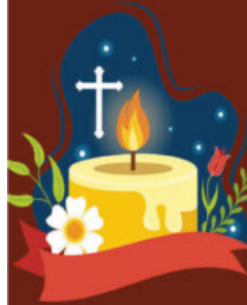

Mentors – Help mothers with life skills financial, and employment skills

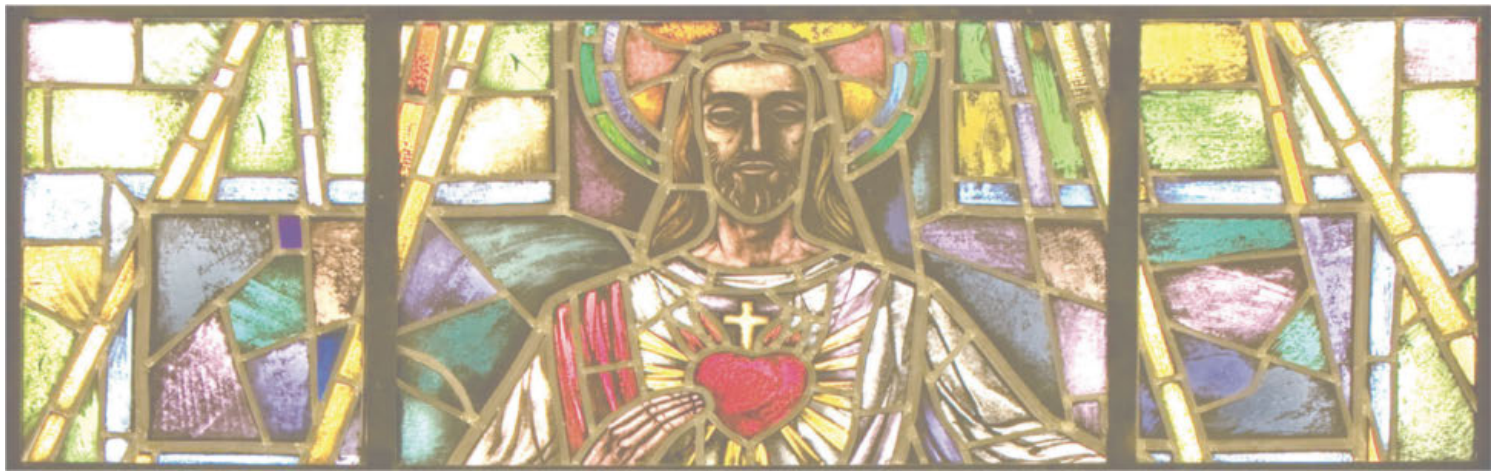

Santa Margarita de Escocia

Reina + Madre + Esposa
+ Evangelista + Inmigrante

Cuando recién fui asignado a esta parroquia, los Caballeros de Colón se pusieron en contacto conmigo y me preguntaron si tenía algún proyecto especial que pudiera encargarles. Tras conversar, decidimos que una estatua de una santa sería una buena idea y me dejaron a mí la tarea de sugerir cuál. Tras pensarlo mucho, elegí a Santa Margarita de Escocia, que vivió entre 1045 y 1093. Hay muchos santos varones canonizados, pero muy pocas mujeres y mucho menos mujeres casadas entre los canonizados.

Margarita nació en el seno de la familia real inglesa, pero nació exiliada en Hungría porque la familia real había huido de Inglaterra debido a la invasión danesa. Regresó a Inglaterra a los 10 años, pero pronto se vio obligada a huir de la invasión normanda de 1066 que derrocó a la Casa anglosajona de Wessex. Decidió volver al continente, donde tenía parientes, pero naufragó en la costa de Escocia, por lo que buscó refugio con Malcolm III, rey de Escocia.

La primera esposa de Malcolm había fallecido, y la pareja real pronto se enamoró y se casó en 1070. Pasaron la vida juntos y tuvieron ocho hijos. El rey Malcolm era corpulento, ruidoso y muy guerrero, y anteriormente había asesinado al usurpador rey Macbeth. Margarita se dedicó a traer cierto grado de civilidad a la alocada corte real escocesa. Cuando Malcolm no estaba fuera destrozando a la gente, la pareja pasaba las tardes juntos en silencio, mientras Margarita le leía historias de la Biblia, traduciendo el latín al instante. Aprovechó su posición para realizar numerosas obras de caridad para los pobres y organizó la construcción de un puente para los peregrinos que visitaban los santuarios locales. Era particularmente devota, animó al clero a difundir la fe, combatió la corrupción y fundó varias iglesias. Atendió personalmente a los pobres en hospitales e incluso logró convencer al rey para que colaborara personalmente en programas de alimentación para los hambrientos. En 1093, al enterarse de la muerte de su esposo en batalla, se desplomó y falleció pocos días después. Fueron enterrados juntos en la Abadía de Dunfermline.

Las crónicas cuentan una historia maravillosa: su tumba se había vuelto tan popular que el lugar era difícil para los peregrinos, por lo que los monjes decidieron construirle un santuario más grande. Pero cuando llegó el momento de trasladar sus restos, desenterraron el ataúd de la santa sin problema, pero una vez colocado en el suelo, no se movía por mucho que empujaban y tiraran. Pronto se dieron cuenta del problema: el rey Malcolm no había sido exhumado junto con su esposa. Así que también lo desenterraron y la pareja real fue trasladada junta.

Santa Margarita es llamada «la perla de Escocia» y es la patrona de las mujeres embarazadas, especialmente de aquellas con embarazos problemáticos, enfermeras y quienes la invocan desde su lecho de muerte. Su festividad es el 16 de noviembre.

Quiero expresar mi más sincero agradecimiento a los Caballeros de Colón por su generosidad al hacer esta donación al Sagrado Corazón.

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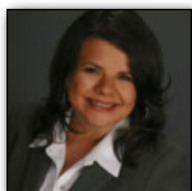


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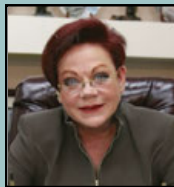


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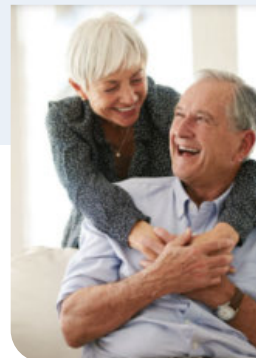


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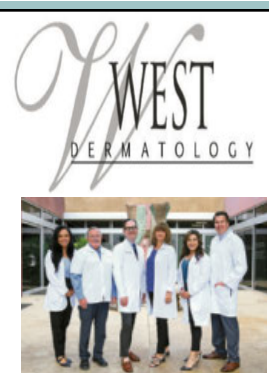


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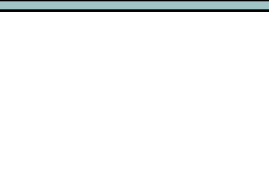


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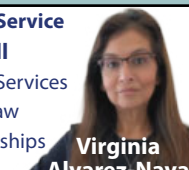
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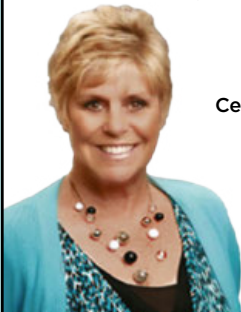
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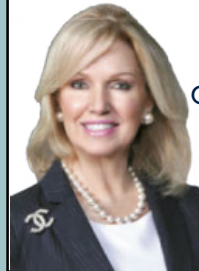
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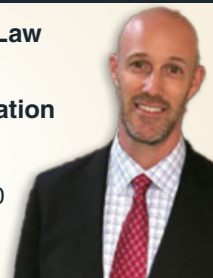
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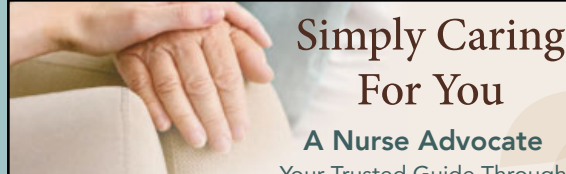
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JUBILEE YEAR OF HOPE 2025



On December 29th, 2024, in accordance with the Holy Father Francis' papal bull *Spes Non Confundit*, every diocese will inaugurate locally the Ordinary Jubilee of the year 2025. In communion with and obedience to those desires promulgated by the Office of the Apostolic Penitentiary, the Diocese of San Bernardino has selected SACRED HEART CHURCH, Palm Desert as a Jubilee site whereat the faithful, having fulfilled the ordinary conditions for the reception of an indulgence, can receive the full remittance of any temporal effects due to sin, opening wide the doors of mercy and hope to an encounter with the risen Lord, in whom our hope "cannot disappoint." (*Spes Non Confundit* 1 - Rom 5:5)

Jubilee 2025 invites you to be a pilgrim of hope. For Christians, hope is anchored in the encounter with Jesus whose life, death, and resurrection reveals God's transforming love. Our hope in God is renewed constantly in the gift of the Holy Spirit, the love of the Father and the Son, who is given, even now, to the community of believers.

For centuries a feature of holy year celebrations has been the indulgence, which the church describes as a remission of the temporal punishment a person is due for their sins.

"Every sin 'leaves its mark'" even after a person has received forgiveness and absolution through the sacrament of reconciliation, Pope Francis wrote in the document proclaiming the Holy Year. "Sin has consequences, not only outwardly in the effects of the wrong we do, but also inwardly, inasmuch as 'every sin, even venial, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death, in the state called Purgatory,'" he wrote, quoting the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The norms for receiving an indulgence during the Holy Year were signed by Cardinal Angelo De Donatis, the new head of the Apostolic Penitentiary, a Vatican court dealing with matters of conscience and with the granting of indulgences.

The basic conditions, he wrote, are that a person is "moved by a spirit of charity," is "purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion" and prays for the pope. Along with a pilgrimage, a work of mercy or an act of penance, a Catholic "will be able to obtain from the treasury of the Church a plenary indulgence, with remission and forgiveness of all their sins, which can be applied in suffrage to the souls in Purgatory."

En comunión y obediencia a los deseos promulgados por la Oficina de la Penitenciaría Apostólica, la Diócesis de San Bernardino ha seleccionado la IGLESIA DEL SAGRADO CORAZÓN, Palm Desert, como lugar del Jubileo donde los fieles, habiendo cumplido las condiciones ordinarias para la recepción de una indulgencia, pueden recibir la remisión completa de los efectos temporales debidos al pecado, abriendo de par en par las puertas de la misericordia y la esperanza a un encuentro con el Señor resucitado, en quien nuestra esperanza "no puede defraudar". (*Spes Non Confundit* 1 - Rom 5:5)*

El Jubileo 2025 te invita a ser un peregrino de esperanza. Para los cristianos, la esperanza está anclada en el encuentro con Jesús, cuya vida, muerte y resurrección revelan el amor transformador de Dios. Nuestra esperanza en Dios se renueva constantemente en el don del Espíritu Santo, el amor del Padre y del Hijo, que se da, incluso ahora, a la comunidad de los creyentes.

Durante siglos, una característica de las celebraciones del Año Santo ha sido la indulgencia, que la Iglesia describe como una remisión de la pena temporal que se debe a una persona por sus pecados.

"Todo pecado 'deja su huella'" incluso después de que una persona haya recibido el perdón y la absolución mediante el sacramento de la reconciliación, escribió el Papa Francisco en el documento de proclamación del Año Santo. "El pecado tiene consecuencias, no solo externas en los efectos del mal que hacemos, sino también internamente, en cuanto "todo pecado, incluso venial, implica un apego maligno a uno, que debe ser purificado ya sea aquí en la tierra, o después de la muerte, en el estado llamado Purgatorio", escribió, citando el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica.

Las normas para recibir indulgencias durante el Año Santo fueron firmadas por el cardenal Angelo De Donatis, el nuevo director de la Penitenciaría Apostólica, un tribunal del Vaticano que se ocupa de los asuntos de conciencia y de la concesión de indulgencias.

Las condiciones básicas, escribió, son que una persona esté "movida por un espíritu de caridad", esté "purificada por el sacramento de la penitencia y reconfortada por la Sagrada Comunión" y ore por el Papa. Junto con una peregrinación, una obra de misericordia o un acto de penitencia, un católico "podrá obtener del tesoro de la Iglesia una indulgencia plenaria, con remisión y perdón de todos sus pecados, que puede ser aplicada en sufragio por las almas del Purgatorio".

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
