At SCC-Milford Campus, Milford, Nebraska

- CRAVE Day is 9:00-2:00
- Instructional time 1 hour plus, lunch & 3 hours job experience
- Lunch with CRAVE participants
- School break: Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break and Easter
- Number of participants: 10
- Can either be or not be a Nebraska VR client
- Can attend during 5th, 6th, &/or 7th year of high school
- Can attend CRAVE for 1 to 3 years (August thru May)
- Can begin program at beginning of year, at quarter or at semester
- School staff complete application online
- Can take classes at SCC-Milford campus (paid for by student & family)
- Orientation week (become familiar with classmates and campus)
- Four non-paid job experiences, about nine weeks – do not interview for these
- Annual IEP Meeting at CRAVE Classroom
- Dress Code: Blue jeans, polo, collared shirt, dress pants, non-slip shoes
- Completion of CRAVE Celebration Ceremony



At York General, York, Nebraska

- Project SEARCH Day is 8:30-3:15
- Instructional time 1 ½ hours & 4 ½ hours Internship
- Lunch and breaks with York General department staff
- School break: Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break and Easter
- Number of participants: 5
- Must be working with Nebraska VR
- Last year of high school (2nd Wednesday of August thru 2nd Wednesday of May)
- Can attend Project SEARCH for only 1 year
- Student must apply for and go thru interview process to be selected for the program
- Program begins in August
- Orientation week – first week and a half of program (in classroom working on resumes, interviews and trainings)
- Transition weeks – in between each internship (in classroom updating resumes, job tours of businesses in town, guest speakers)
- Three non-paid internships, about 10 weeks each – prior to internship will interview for internship & 8 weeks into the internship will turn in a resignation letter
- Must participate in York General training, department meetings and quarterly all staff meetings
- Monthly Internship Team Meeting, plus an annual IEP meeting
- Dress Code: wear attire set by department (ie. Scrubs, non slip shoes, dress pants, collared shirt, etc.)
- Graduation celebration in May – receive high school diploma from school representative and Project SEARCH Certificate
