

- What is the overall goal amount that is desired to be raised?
  - 84 students - \$800/kid - roughly \$67,200
- Should we pay our students' trip in full if fundraising is to be deducted for our student?
  - You should not pay in full if you wish to have funds raised deducted from their account.
- Will the funds be periodically deducted from the student accounts?
  - Yes
- Tip nights generally have the best results in the first hour. How do we disperse the funds evenly if the funds aren't evenly raised?
  - Suggestions include splitting the pot evenly between the volunteer students for that event or staggering nights between smaller groups of students rather than one overall event.
- Is there a limit to how many fundraisers can be held?
  - This is not limited because it is not for sports
- If payments are made on time they will be paid off by March 15th. Should we continue to raise funds after that date?
  - Suggestion was to have fundraisers complete by Christmas (tentatively)
- Is there a penalty on Bennett travel for payment deadlines?
  - No, as long as the final deadline is met
- Can we start a parent Facebook group to share the events?
  - Concerns were full inclusion and admin approval
- Could we do a live Google doc to include the parent group to note which businesses have been contacted and who have supported?
  - Good idea, needs to be generated with the email list
- Should we keep fundraising to the Tawas area specifically, avoiding the surrounding areas?
  - Suggested to keep it closer to local but Hale Fairgrounds Halloween weekend might be an exception because it is Iosco County Fairgrounds
