STRATEGIC THEME: CULTURE FOR LEARNING

Priority Statement: Stakeholders are included and actively engaged in creating and sustaining a healthy culture for learning that meets the needs of all students.

- Objective: Develop a school environment where all students feel intellectually safe and have opportunities to succeed
 - Critical Initiative: Establish clear, consistent, and accessible communication strategies across all platforms (email, social media, school websites) to ensure timely information reaches all stakeholders
 - **Intended Outcome**: The number of "hits" and responses will show an increase in communication.
 - Key measure: Number of website views and Facebook followers
 - Activity: Remind/parent email/student email to communicate important information
 - Activity: Post updates and reminders on website and Social media
 - o **Critical Initiative:** Conduct a student survey concerning student interest and engagement.
 - **Intended Outcome:** The student survey will show students are interested/engaged in their academics.
 - Key measure: Student survey results
 - Activity: Class selection based upon interests, short/long term goals.
 - Activity: SPED population interest inventory and/or student preference survey.
 - o Critical Initiative: Conduct monthly sessions via Zoom for mental and emotional health.
 - Intended Outcome: Students will feel comfortable talking with counselors concerning mental and emotional health.
 - **Key measure:** Documentation of Zoom meetings.
 - **Activity:** Monthly ZOOM sessions covering topics related to healthy choices and in person counseling sessions.

STRATEGIC THEME: LEADERSHIP FOR LEARNING

Priority Statement: Schools are equipped with student focused leaders who engage in their own learning, communicate consistently and express clear expectations for staff and students.

- Objective: Promote and lead professional growth opportunities from leadership at the school level.
 - o Critical Initiative: Provide professional growth through staff development activities.
 - Intended Outcome: All staff will gain knowledge necessary to personalize instruction.
 - **Key measure**: Staff development agendas/sign in sheets.
 - Activity: School planning off campus retreat in the summer.
 - Activity: State/district/school webinars and ZOOMS throughout the year.
 - Critical Initiative: Ensure equitable allocation of human, material, digital, and fiscal resources.
 - **Intended Outcome:** Teachers will have resources necessary to implement instruction effectively.
 - Key measure: Financial documents.
 - Activity: Budget meetings for spending technology budget.
 - o **Critical Initiative:** Set high expectations for student achievement and learning through effective, innovative, and collaborative engagement of district school leaders and staff.
 - Intended Outcome: All staff will gain knowledge necessary to personalize instruction.
 - **Key measure:** Walkthroughs/observations
 - Activity: Collaboration between counselors within the county pertaining to topics and issues affecting students

STRATEGIC THEME: ENGAGEMENT OF LEARNING

Priority Statement: Stakeholders are included and actively engaged in creating and sustaining a healthy culture for learning that meets the needs of all students.

- **Objective**: Develop SMART goals for accountability indicators.
 - o Critical Initiative: Increase Math/ELA by 3% on the ACAP Summative
 - **Intended Outcome**: Students will be more engaged in learning to demonstrate increased scores on state assessments.
 - Key measure: Achievement data.
 - Activity: Math Coach/Reading Coach now in place
 - Activity: Number talks at the beginning of each ZOOM
 - Activity: After school tutoring for ACAP Summative/Literacy Camp
 - o Critical Initiative: Increase Math/ELA by 3% on the ACT.
 - Intended Outcome: Students will be more engaged in learning to demonstrate increased scores on state assessments.
 - Key measure: Achievement data.
 - Activity: ACT ELA/Math Prep courses offered to students as electives
 - Activity: 36U programs
 - Activity: After school tutoring for ACT.
 - o Critical Initiative: Increase Math/ELA by 2% on the ACAP Summative in the SPED subgroup.
 - **Intended Outcome:** Students will be more engaged in learning to demonstrate increased scores on state assessments.
 - Key measure: Achievement data.
 - **Activity:** IXL/Classwork program assigned to at-risk student and students who have an IEP plan in place for additional instruction/intervention.
 - Activity: After school tutoring for ACAP Summative/ACT
 - o Critical Initiative: Achieve 95% in the College and Career readiness rate and Graduation rate.
 - **Intended Outcome:** Develop life skills to think critically, set goals, communicate, collaborate, and achieve credential.
 - Key measure: Accountability indicators.
 - Activity: Monitoring of CCR credentials in the AIM portal.
 - Activity: Monitoring student transcripts for required graduation requirements.
 - Activity: WorkKeys given to 9th/10th grade students to earn CCR credentials
 - Activity: After school tutoring for WorkKeys

STRATEGIC THEME: GROWTH IN LEARNING

Priority Statement: Learners are positively impacted with engaging material, college and career readiness, and development of knowledge and skills to prepare them for the next transition.

- Objective: Maintain attendance by addressing chronic absenteeism to help decrease retention rate
 - o **Critical Initiative**: Communicate with students/parents to see the importance of attendance on their educational futures.
 - **Intended Outcome**: Students/parents will understand the importance of attendance and how it correlates with academics with a reduced retention rate of less than 3%.
 - Key measure: Communication documentation.
 - Activity: Monitoring Progress through course virtual platforms.
 - Activity: Phone calls/emails communicating with parents of students with chronic
 - Activity: Develop attendance goals for students who have more than 10% absences.
