Dear Silver Streak Families,

Thank you for coming out and supporting us for Open House, ESOL Night, PTO Spirit Night, and our Pastries with Pals. We had AMAZING participation! Our Silver Streaks continues to average above 90% for attendance during the month of September! Super Proud! The students are increasing their Accelerated Reader (AR) points in each grade level and we appreciate all the support to read each night for twenty minutes. We love giving out the reading awards each Friday as students hit benchmarks for the number of words they have read. We appreciate the support of the Lake Wales Charter office as we have received additional classroom libraries for our brand new staff members.

As we continue our journey with the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IB PYP), we are focusing on activities and procedures in the classroom to increase student agency. Student agency is "giving children the power to act in their own learning." This means that we need to give students both the option to make choices to direct their own learning and the information they need to make strong choices to empower themselves. The terms "voice and choice" comes up a lot around student agency and "voice and informed choice" is used when making decisions for learning in the classroom.

The term "student agency" often overlaps with the language around assessments because our teachers use assessment data as a foundation to help build student voice and choice. John Hattie's work shows us that when students have agency and efficacy within their learning and understand their growth and mastery of academic content, they are assessment-capable learners.

Currently, the students are updating their student data folders from progress monitoring to make academic goals and to reflect on the progress that is needed this year. We look forward to seeing our families on campus for our conference day on October 16th. Please reach out to your child's teacher to reserve those times.

The teachers are encouraging the students to read all of their directions twice and re-read as necessary in all subject areas. The students are becoming more responsible for their reading in the ELA block learning the various genres and story elements. In Math, the students are using various manipulatives to solve word problems and computation problems, successfully. In Social Studies, the students are becoming more aware of their community and the world around them. In Science, the students are working on various ways to classify matter and identifying the difference between living vs. nonliving. So, as you can see, our First Graders are very busy at school. Second Grade

We're working hard in Second Grade!! Students have become familiarized with their classroom procedures and expectations. In Reading, students are learning about different story elements and text features. They are enjoying UFLI and look forward to the daily lessons. In Math, we are learning place value and comparing numbers. Students have shown great interest in these topics and look forward to learning about 2D shapes next. As we learn about the human body and functions of major organs, second grade teachers predict we may have future medical field workers here at JHW.

Fifth Grade

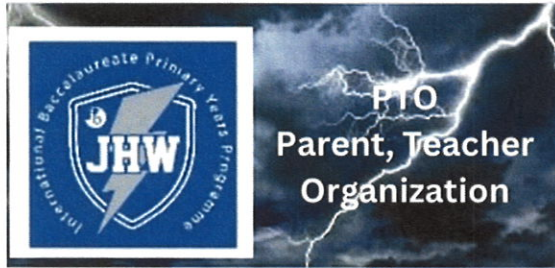
For the month of September in Math, students will be learning about place value and multi-digit numbers and decimals to the thousandths place. Students will also be focusing on Topic 3: Multiplying multi-digit whole numbers, understanding multiplication with decimals, as well as adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing multi-digit numbers. We will be continuously practicing our math facts and encourage students and their families to practice them at home. In ELA, we will be focusing on poetry. Students should be reading at least 20 minutes a day and recording a summary in their reading logs. We will be focusing on argumentative writing. In Science, we will be learning about sharing the planet adaptation of organisms, flow of energy in a food chain, organs of the human body, classification of plants and animals, and life cycles of plants and animals). In Social Studies and Writing, students will be working on the Daughters of the American Revolution Essay. Information will be posted on Dojo and sent home in Thursday Communication Folders. These essays are due to Dr. Klepacki no later than November 1st. Please support and encourage your students to complete their homework each night. Mrs. Sotomayor (math) has a math folder where homework is to be completed. Mrs. Maldonado (ELA) and Dr. Klepacki (science/social studies) share ONE homework journal.
