



THE 15 PROMISES OF THE ROSARY


Pope St. John Paul II called the Rosary “an exquisitely contemplative prayer.” The benefits of praying the Rosary are enumerated in a special way in the *Fifteen Promises of the Blessed Mother*. This is a tradition held by the Dominicans that St. Dominic received a private revelation from the Blessed Virgin giving him fifteen Promises for all those who pray the Rosary devoutly and faithfully (see below). We hope that they encourage you in meditating on the mysteries of Christ by

praying the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

1. Those who faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary shall receive signal graces.
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against Hell. It will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.
4. The recitation of the Rosary will cause virtue and good works to flourish. It will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God. It will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.
5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.
6. Those who recite my Rosary devoutly, applying themselves to the consideration of its sacred mysteries, shall never be conquered by misfortune. In His justice, God will not chastise them; nor shall they perish by an unprovided death, i.e., be unprepared for heaven. Sinners shall convert. The just shall persevere in grace and become worthy of eternal life.
7. Those who have a true devotion to the Rosary shall not die without the sacraments of the Church.
8. Those who faithfully recite the Rosary shall have, during their life and at their death, the light of God and the plenitude of His graces. At the moment of death, they shall participate in the merits of the saints in Paradise.
9. I shall deliver from Purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.
10. The faithful children of the Rosary shall merit a high degree of glory in Heaven.
11. By the recitation of the Rosary, you shall obtain all that you ask of me.
12. Those who propagate the holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.
13. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire celestial court during their life and at the hour of their death.
14. All who recite the Rosary are my beloved children and the brothers and sisters of my only Son, Jesus Christ.
15. Devotion to my Rosary is a great sign of predestination.



Taking pictures or videos of a minor without permission: What can be done if a person is taking pictures of a minor in a public place? Although it is legal that a person can take pictures or videos in a public place, there are sometimes extenuating circumstances that require adults to pay more attention. Is the person taking photos acting suspiciously — focusing on only minor children, for example, or zooming in on specific body areas of their subjects? Are they hovering around groups of children with no seeming reason for being there? If you have concerns, speak up. Ask why the photos are being taken, or if the person is willing to delete the images of your child. From there, you can decide if you need to get the authorities involved. 
WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

Larcy on Pilgrimage



I got the lead for this story when an unsuspecting person called to see if a priest was available to bless a new vehicle. "Yes, I am available," I said on the phone. "Come to the Parish office on El Molino." After the blessing, I asked, "So, where do you live?" "On Sierra Vista Avenue, near Almanson Park," says she. "Oh, that's in our Parish. Would it be alright if I interviewed you for a story to be put in our Parish bulletin," I slyly asked. Bingo! Meet **Larcy Ramos**.

She's from a small town some 15 miles north of Manila and is the youngest of five. Larcy is single and lives with her cousin, Mai. She is a graduate of Santo Tomas in Manila. (This university was founded in 1611, making it older than Harvard!) Larcy credits her Catholic education to her being deeply rooted in her faith. After college, Larcy worked in a couple of banks in Manila.

In 1987, Larcy moved to the States to help her sister and her husband with their French bakery in Rancho Palos Verdes. She moved to Alhambra around 1993 and has been a parishioner of St. Therese Parish Church ever since. She remembers well when the relics of St. Therese visited our Parish. The Great Jubilee of 2000 was just beginning, and the Parish was celebrating its diamond jubilee. (Don't forget, the

relics of St. Therese will return here one year from now.)

Around the year 2000, Larcy was employed by WorldCom, the telecom company that went bankrupt due to the biggest financial scandal in U.S. history. Along with 18,000 other employees, Larcy was laid off. The silver lining for her was that she was now able to fulfill her ambition to become a chef. She enrolled at the Cordon Bleu School of Culinary Arts in Pasadena. On weekends, she'd earn money working at catering events in LA and Orange County. These events brought her into contact with famous chefs such as Wolfgang Puck and Joachim Splichal, quite a confidence builder, she says. Eventually, Larcy was hired by Whole Foods Market as a cook.

The kitchen is Larcy's happy place. She is grateful to God every day that she is able to do the things she loves doing and make people happy and satisfied with their meals. That includes the times she has used her culinary skills to make delicious soup for St. Therese Parish's Lenten Soup Nights.

Larcy is semi-retired now and has the opportunity to travel. She has made pilgrimages to Italy, Spain, Portugal, and France. On her first trip to Rome, she attended Pope Francis' midnight Christmas Mass at St. Peter's. She says that while praying in the holy places, tears would involuntarily fall on her cheeks. Her cup was overflowing. Last year, she traveled to Lourdes. Next year she hopes to visit Lisieux since she is attached to St. Therese. (I told her about the pilgrimage Fr. Peter Mary and Fr. Robert are leading next year.)

I learned that Larcy's sister, Ruby Ramos, is a well-known parishioner of St. Therese and has four children. One of those, her daughter Anna, cantored here for a while. Ruby is now widowed.

Larcy concluded her interview quoting the Little Flower: "*What matters in life is not great deeds, but great love,*" meaning that the ordinary things we do become extraordinary when done with love. These words always resonate in Larcy's grateful heart. Let it be so with all of us.

Thank you for sharing, Larcy!



