Practice At Home

- ❖ Read and write together! After your child finishes reading a story, challenge them to add onto their story in writing OR write a retell of the main events. Pay close attention to spelling!
- ❖ For math, practice adding and subtracting numbers using a variety of different strategies. These strategies might include decomposing numbers, using a number line, or drawing the base ten form of the numbers to add or subtract, etc.

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: We are reviewing all the spelling patterns we have learned so far this year! We will use our knowledge of these patterns and the six syllable types to decode and encode all kinds of multisyllable words.
Reading: This week students will take what they've learned about the specific pollinator they researched and draw diagrams with captions of the pollinator moving pollen from flower to flower. The drawings will be paired with notecards of what they will say when they present it to students in other classes.
Math: We are continuing to investigate the uses of graphs.
Science: We are finishing up our glue engineering unit this week! Last week we glued together picture frames with our final glue. This week we will reflect on what we've learned about properties of different substances and how those properties can change.
