Mr. McCook shared information about Demon Time-instructional time designated on Tuesdays to focus on instruction. Returned to going over DemonPride in Rockin R (homeroom) on Thursdays to build those relationships. Rockin R will also address social skills like class etiquette, speaking to adults, and conflict resolution. Academic targets such as transcript checks, and SAT prep will be discussed in Rockin R as well.

Teachers are focused on Tier 1 instruction and teaching standards in the classroom.

Q: Vape Sensors: Still in the planning stage. McCook going to Merriweather and/or Bleckley to see it in action but principals on board and process is ongoing. New feature can be set on decibels and would allow limits of number in the area/based on noise volume. On-going research.

Q: Walk-through suggestions -some small fixes, others on list for future renovation

We do have 2 SRO's and changed the bathroom pass to color coded by building to cut down on wandering and incidents.

McCook also shared that enrollment is up but 9<sup>th</sup> graders are well behaved (1<sup>st</sup> group in full time school previous 3 years post Covid) and the school year is off to a great start.

Ecovase is used to cut down on germ spread.

New Policies: phones put away and is working, vape policy 3 strike to alternative school, fights are now monitored with contracts and 3 strikes to alternative based on severity. All policies are enforced, but the focus again is on R3. Punishment doesn't change the behavior.
