# HOW TO EARN YOUR READING REWARDS



## AT SFPL IN JUNE & JULY



- Earn one(1) ticket each day you visit SFPL to check out materials and one(1) ticket for each SR2026 program you participate in from June 1, 2026 - July 25, 2026.
- Start bringing your BINGO sheet with you every time you come to SFPL in June & July. Earn **one(1) ticket each time you complete a BINGO** (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal). Earn 1 extra ticket 6/5/26 - 7/25/26 by turning in your completed BINGO sheet to an SFPL staff member!
- Redeem the tickets you earn for SFPL Summer Reading reward items from the Prize Catalog or for a Treasure Machine item.
- Track your reading in JUNE & JULY with the **UNEARTH A STORY** TIME TRACKER. For every 12 minutes you spend reading Between June 1st & July 24th, mark a dot on the page; 600 minutes is your summer goal! Ask for a Reading Log if you want to keep track of the list of titles you read throughout the summer :)
- Participate in the many Summer Reading activities, events, & programs available at the library to earn more tickets! [We have programs for ALL AGES! Check the summer calendar for dates, times, and any necessary registration details for individual programs.](#)
- Earn a Loot Bag entry for each completed Time Tracker sheet and/or each completed BINGO sheet when you turn one in by July 25, 2026.

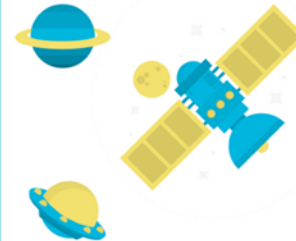
